

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12465  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Deer's Den, roundhouses 195m and 250m S of comprises the cropmarked remains of at least seven roundhouses of probable Iron-Age date (late 1<sup>st</sup> millennium BC/early 1<sup>st</sup> millennium AD). They are sited in pasture to the west of the A96 trunk road at Kintore, 60m above sea level. The remains of the roundhouses are clearly defined as cropmarks in aerial photographs and vary from 5m to 10m in diameter. The area to be scheduled has two parts, one irregular and one a cropped circle on plan, to include the remains described and an area around within which evidence relating to their construction and use may survive. Specifically excluded from the scheduling are the above-ground elements of all stone dykes and post-and-wire fences, to allow for their maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kintore and the County of Aberdeen as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

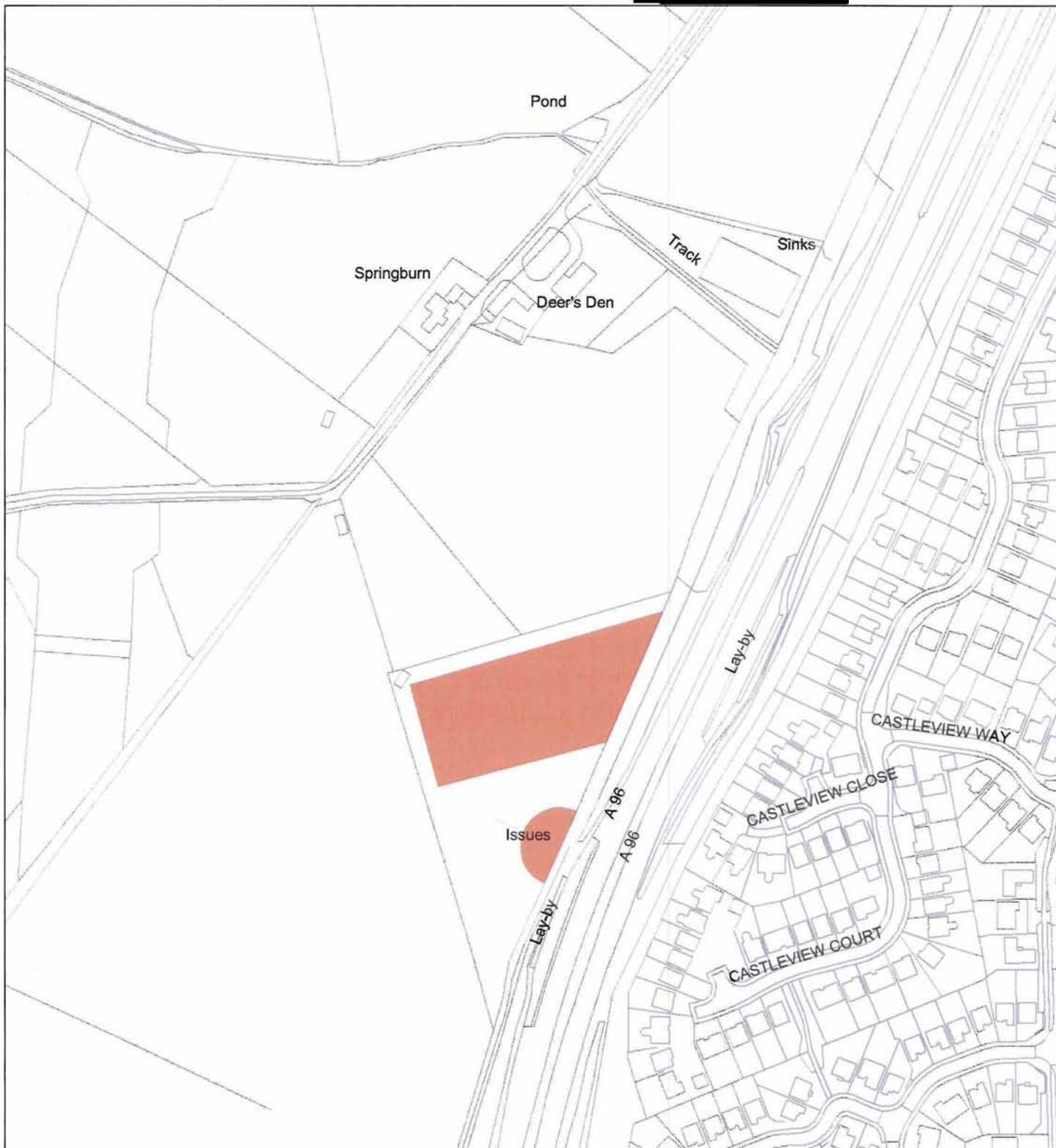
