

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12520
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Sands of Forvie, cairns 1115m SE of Waterside comprises the remains of three kerb cairns surviving as exposed stone mounds. They are located in the coastal dunes of the Sands of Forvie nature reserve at 20m above sea level. The northernmost cairn is 5m in diameter. The SE cairn measures 5m in diameter and 0.3m in height; a kerb is visible on the north-west and south-east. The SW cairn measures 5m in diameter and stands to a height of 0.2m. The area to be scheduled is rectilinear on plan, to include the remains described and an area around within which evidence relating to their construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Slains and the County of Aberdeen as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]
