

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12565
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as 5 Shethin Cottages, homestead moat 125m SSW of comprises the remains of a homestead moat of late medieval date and visible as a cropmark within cultivated land. The monument is located at 55m above sea level and 140m to the north of the Yowlie Burn. The visible traces of the monument consist of three sides of a ditched rectilinear enclosure measuring 56m from NNW to SSE by 58m transversely. The ditch measures between 8m and 10m in width, the N section being consistently wider than the S and W portion. The interior of the monument measures 36m from NNW to SSE by 43m transversely. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, to include the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Tarves and the County of Aberdeen as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

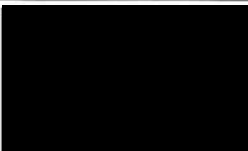

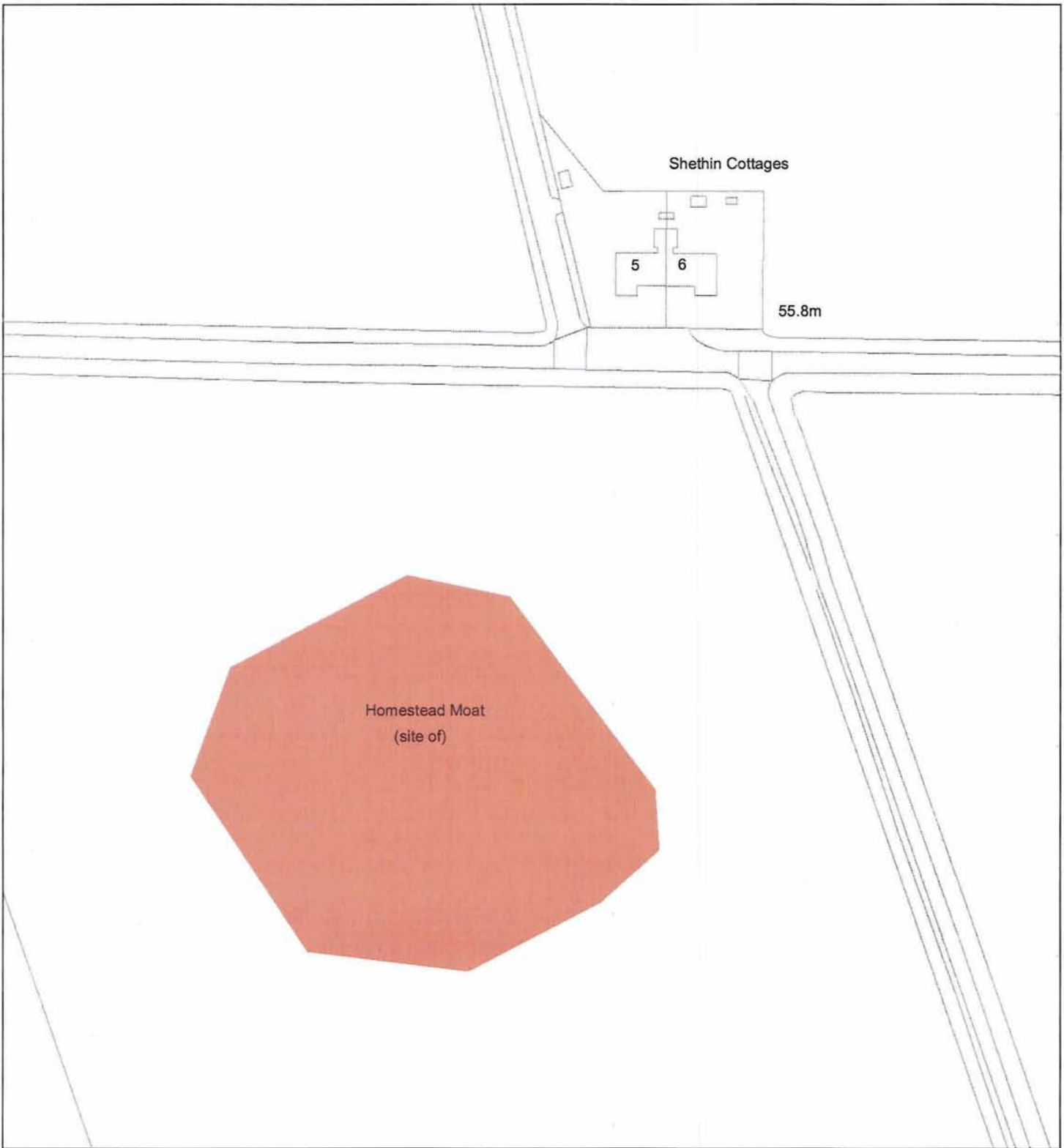
