

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12579
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Rathburne House, tower house 180m NNW of comprises the ruined remains of a rectangular tower and its associated barmkin enclosure that date to the later medieval period. It is situated in a field 180m NNW of Rathburne Hotel at a height of 210m above sea level. Rectangular on plan, the tower measures 12m by 11m and survives as four turf-covered walls standing to a height of 1m. The tower is situated at the top of a steep S-facing slope overlooking the course of the Eye Water. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, to include the remains described and an area around within which evidence relating to their construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Longformacus and the County of Berwick as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

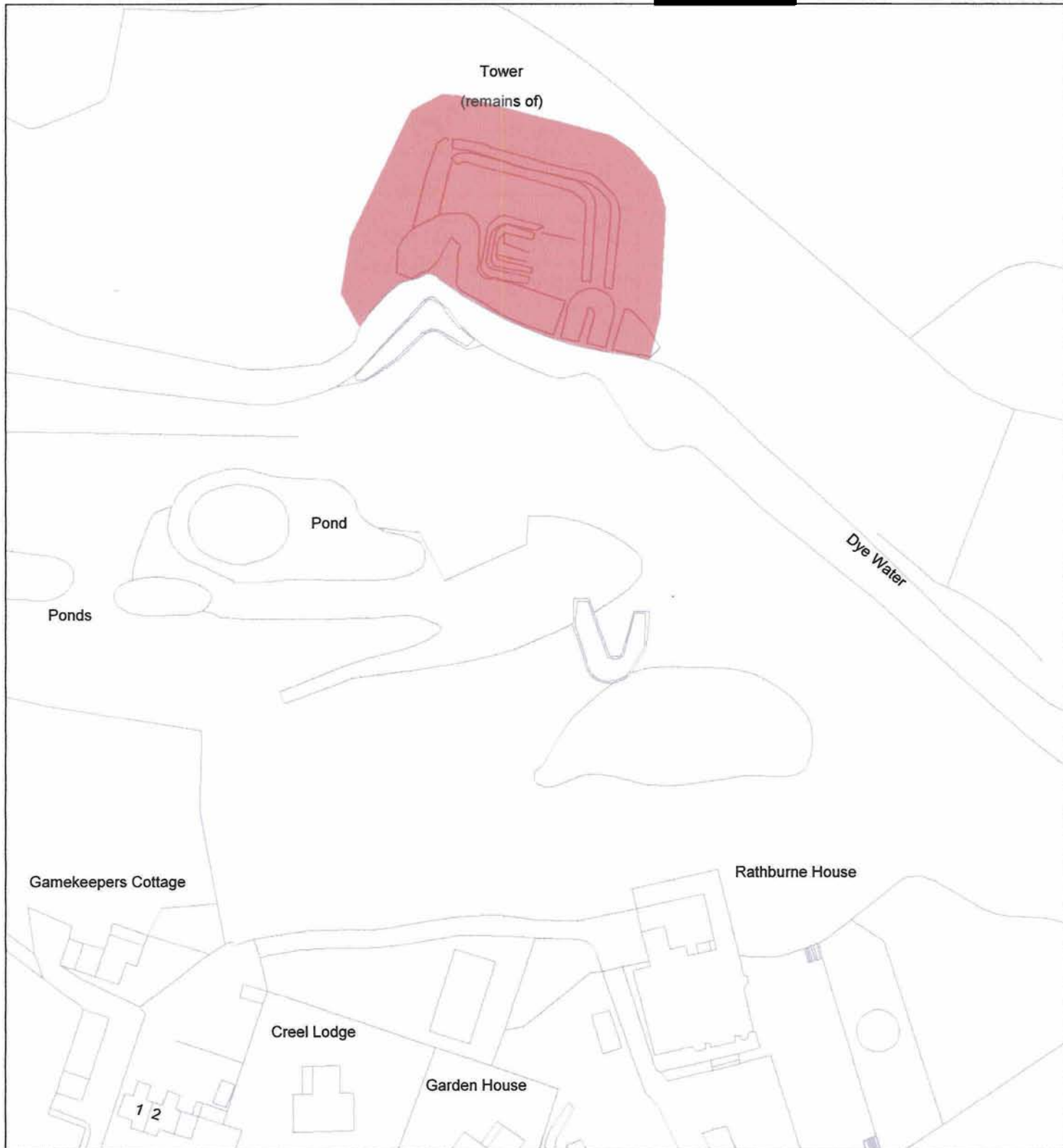
