

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12719
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Bodesbeck, standing stone 1180m E of comprises a single large monolith likely to be Neolithic or early Bronze Age in date (the third or second millennium BC). The stone occupies a position approximately 385m above sea level on the SE side of Moffatdale, where it sits on a terrace to the north of Bodesbeck Burn. The area to be scheduled is circular on plan, centred on stone, to include the remains described and an area around in which evidence relating to its erection and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Moffat and the County of Dumfries as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

[REDACTED], is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
