

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12757  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Doune Roman Fort, fort 60m S of Doune Primary School comprises the buried remains of a Roman fort, visible from the air as cropmarks indicating the line of the triple defensive ditch. The fort lies on a level promontory at around 40m above sea level, and 20m above the surrounding low lying land. The promontory overlooks the River Teith, 120m to the south, and Doune Castle, which is 170m to the SSE. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, to include the remains described above and an area around them within which related material may be expected to survive. The scheduled area extends up to but excludes the fences on all sides. It also excludes the top 300mm of the cricket pitch and playing fields to allow for their maintenance for recreational activities. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmadock and the County of Perth as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

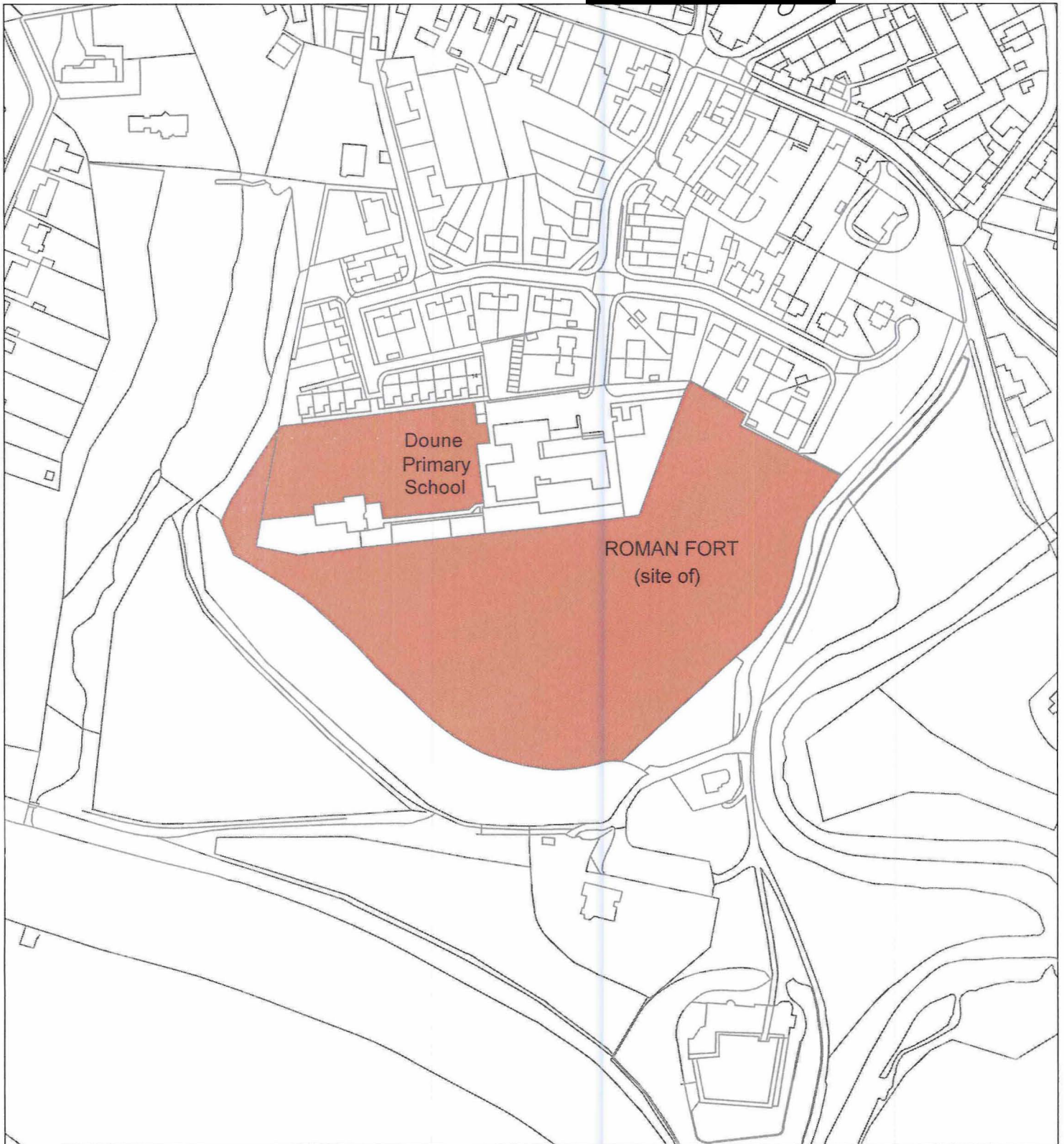
