

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12812
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Elliston Castle comprises the remains of Elliston Castle, a late medieval tower house. It is visible as the ruins of the main tower and an adjoining rectangular barmkin, situated within the garden of Elliston House. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, to include the remains described and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment may survive. The area to be scheduled specifically excludes the above ground elements of all post-and-rail and timber fences, spotlights, garden ornaments, signage and garden steps. The upper 100mm of all patios within the scheduled area are specifically excluded to allow for maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Lochwinnoch and the County of Renfrew as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

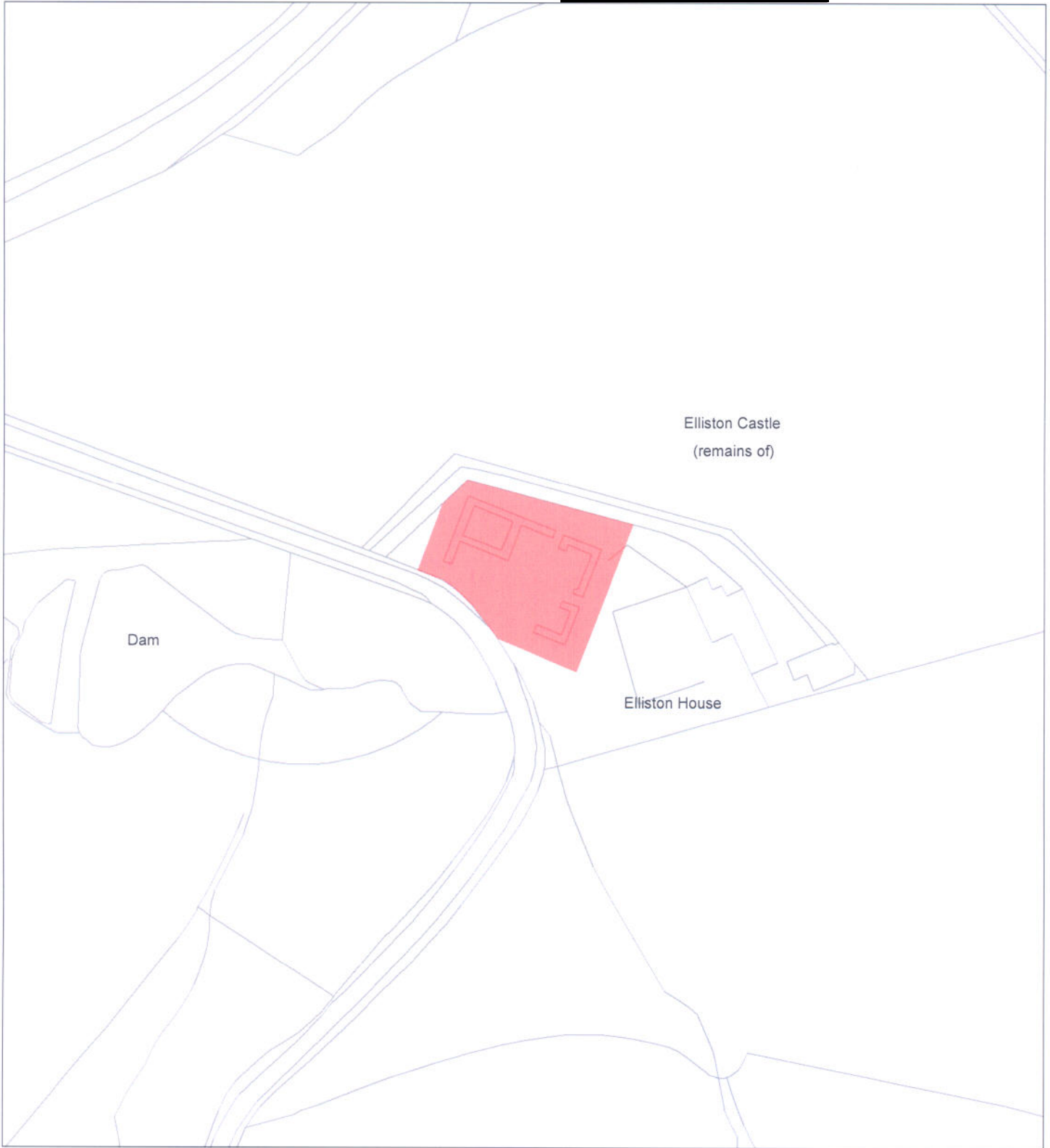
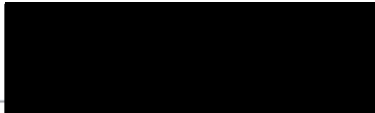
