

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12887
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Ladymuir, settlement 2.3km W of comprises the remains of three hut circles, possibly of Late Bronze Age or Iron Age date (late second or first millennium BC). One of the hut circles has an enclosure around it which is interpreted as a yard and the other two are unenclosed. The hut circles appear as roughly circular features built of earth and stones. They are situated on an E-facing slope around Cat Craig, at a height of around 250m above sea level and around 230m W of Gotter Water. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, to include the remains described above and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmacolm and the County of Renfrew as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

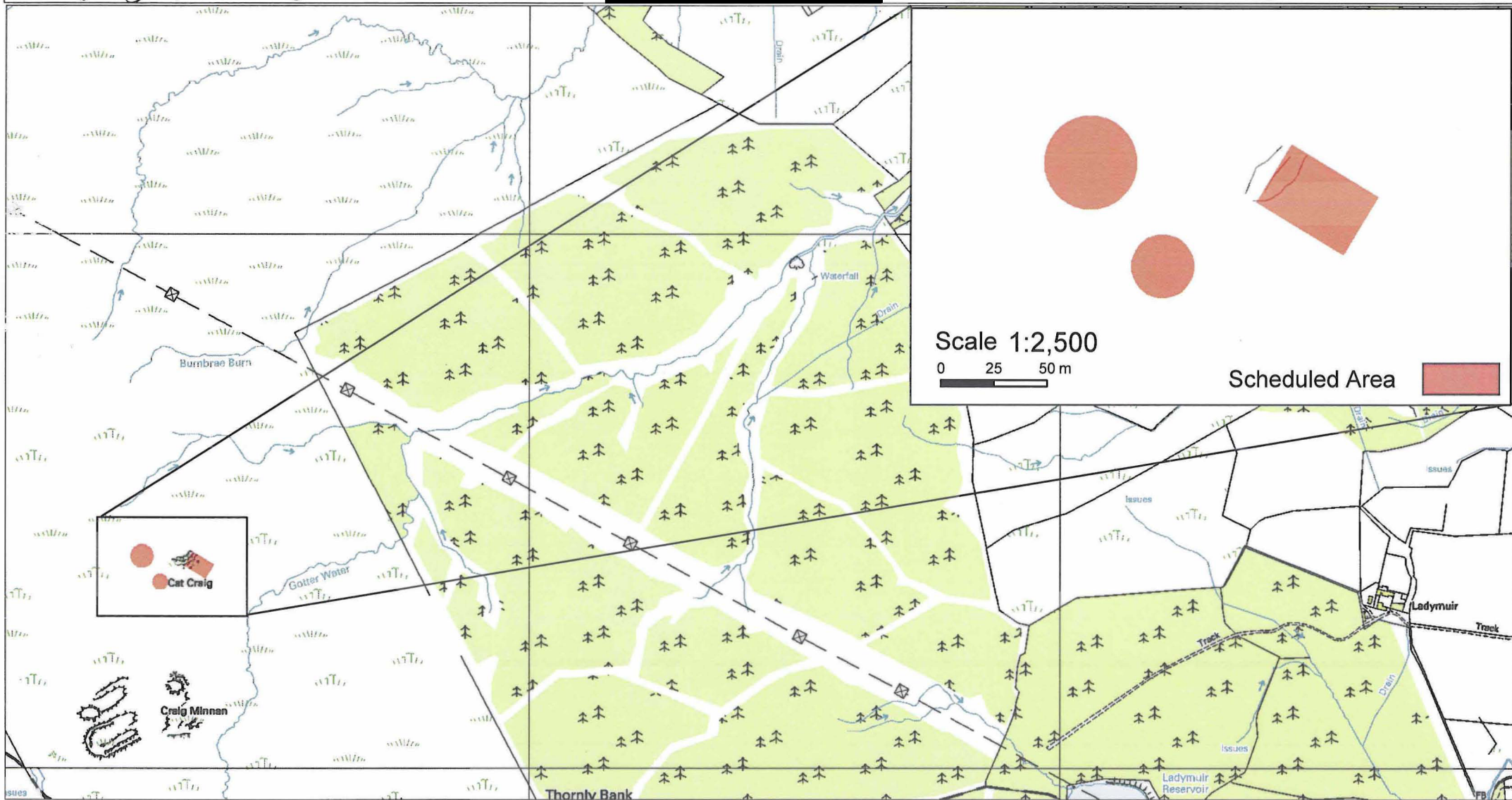

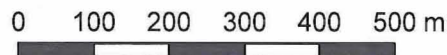
Kilmacolm Parish
