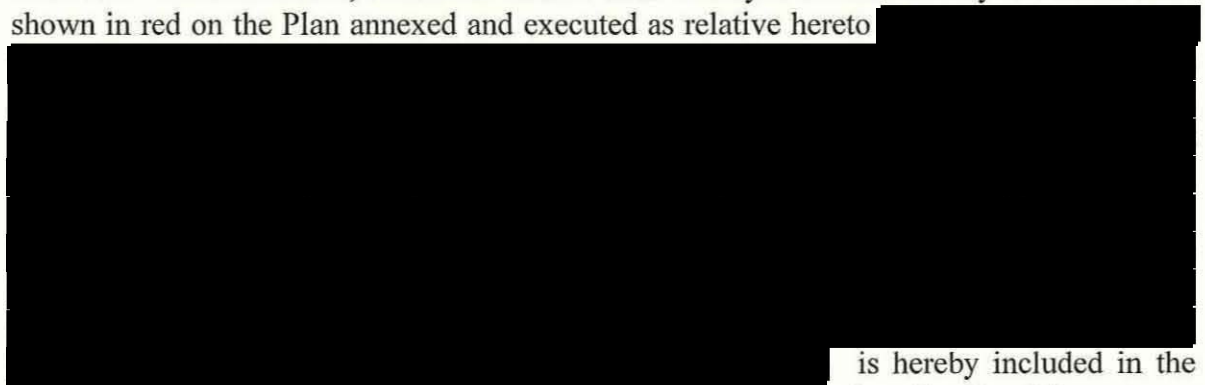


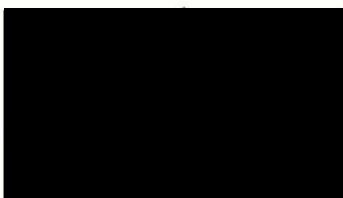
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12924
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Old Rayne, episcopal manse and moat 45m ENE of Old Rayne School comprises the earthworks of a moat that encloses the buried remains of an episcopal manor house. It is situated in a formerly cultivated field approximately 30m east of Old Rayne School. The complex dates to the later medieval period, with occupation possibly from the mid 12th to mid 16th centuries. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, to include the remains described above and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment may survive. The above-ground elements of all post-and-wire fences are specifically excluded. The above-ground elements of the stone boundary wall running along the W side of the scheduled area are also excluded. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rayne and the County of Aberdeen as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

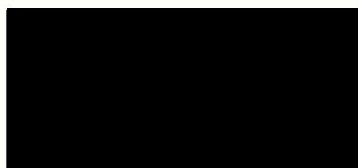

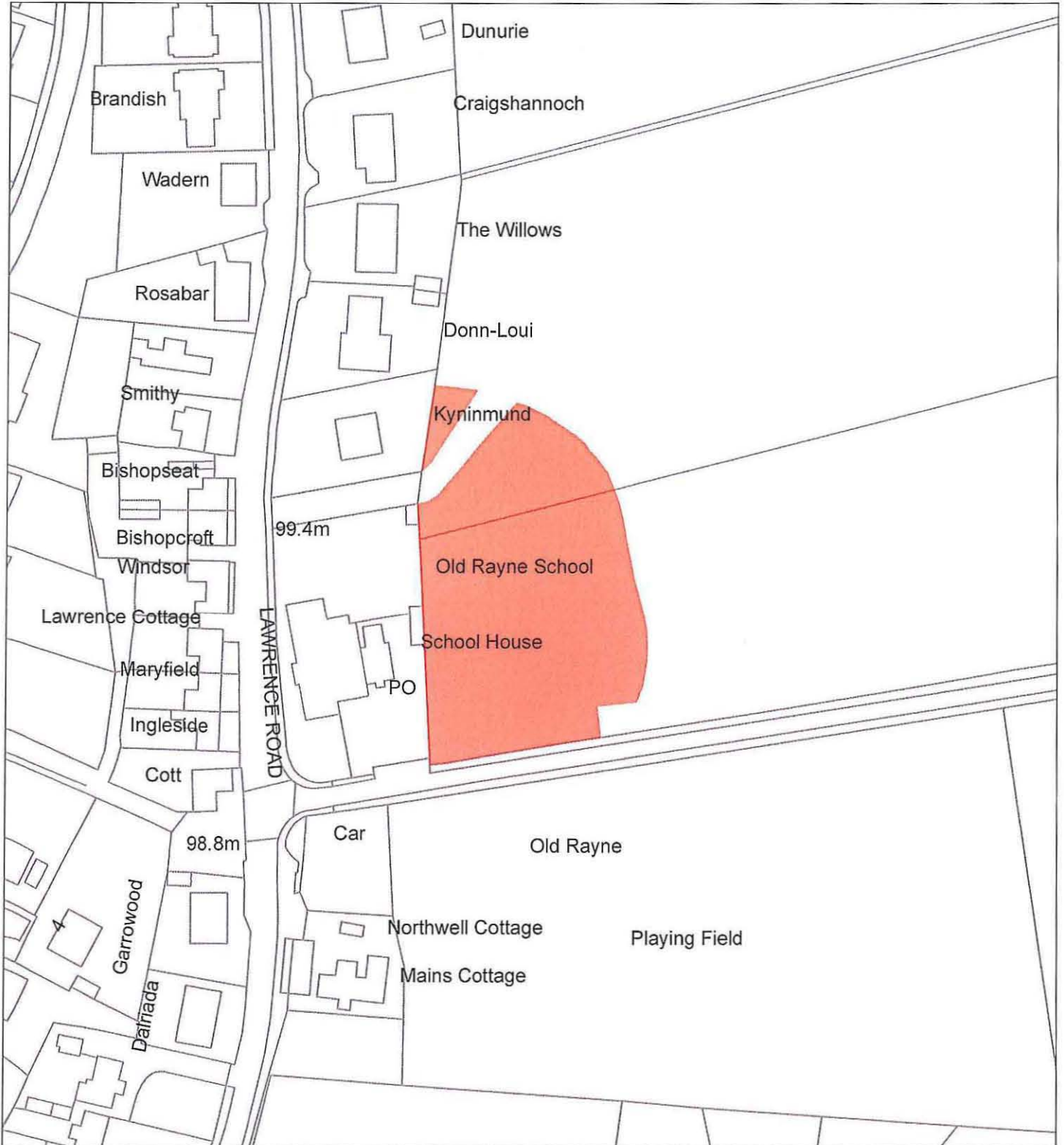
