

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 13049
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Sound, laird's house, chapel and burial ground 220m SSE of Oversound comprises the remains of an 18th-century laird's house, known as the Haa of Sound, and associated structures, the fishing station of Sound, including bōds (fishermen's booths or huts), and a burial ground within which the remains of Our Lady's Chapel are found. The monument lies on the west side of Weisdale Voe, just above sea level. The area to be scheduled is irregular in plan, to include the buildings, enclosures, piers, graveyard and an area around these within which associated remains are likely to survive. The modern gate allowing access to the field immediately to the south is specifically excluded from the scheduling to allow for its maintenance. All active burial lairs are specifically excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Tingwall and the County of Orkney and Zetland as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

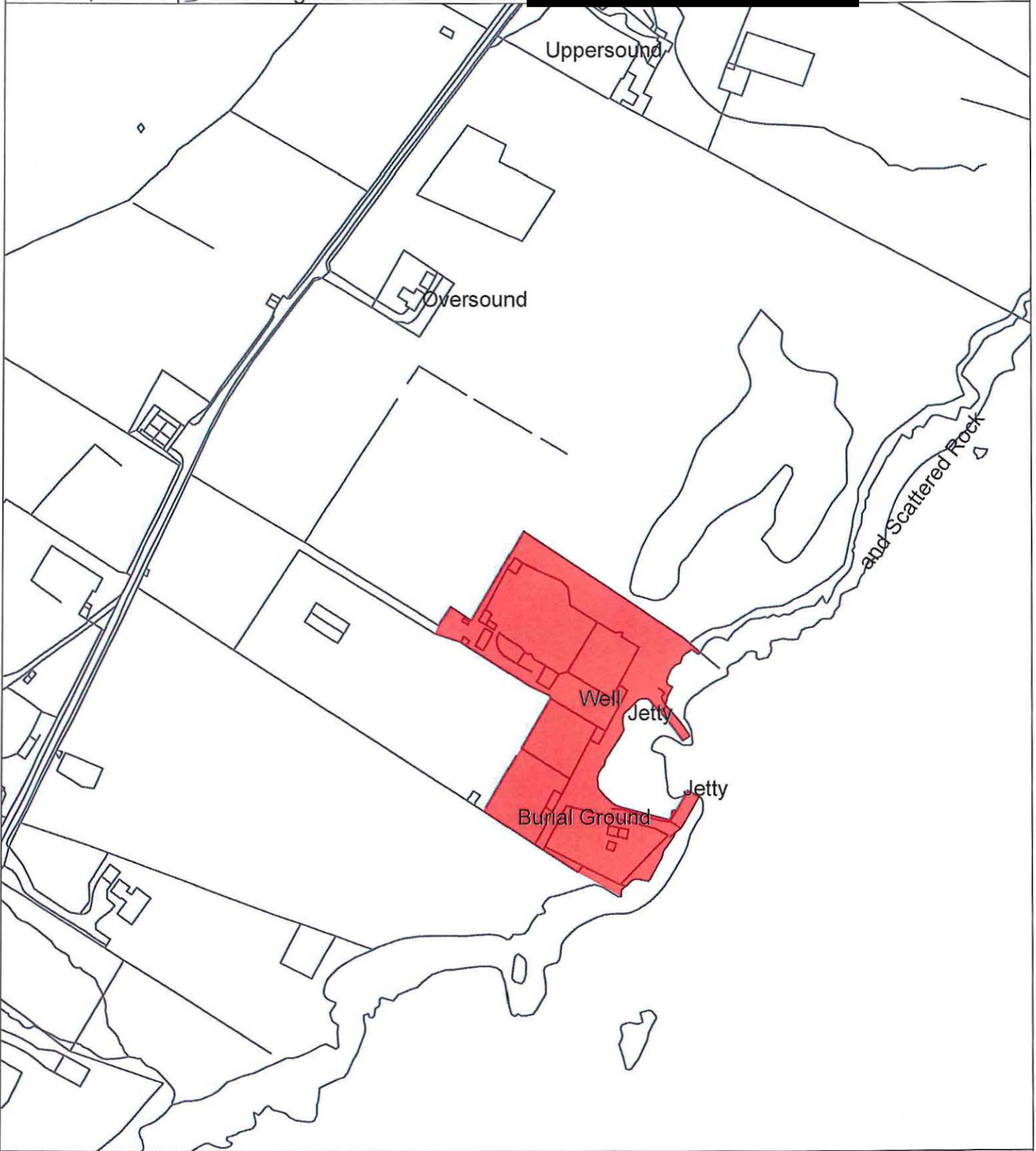
