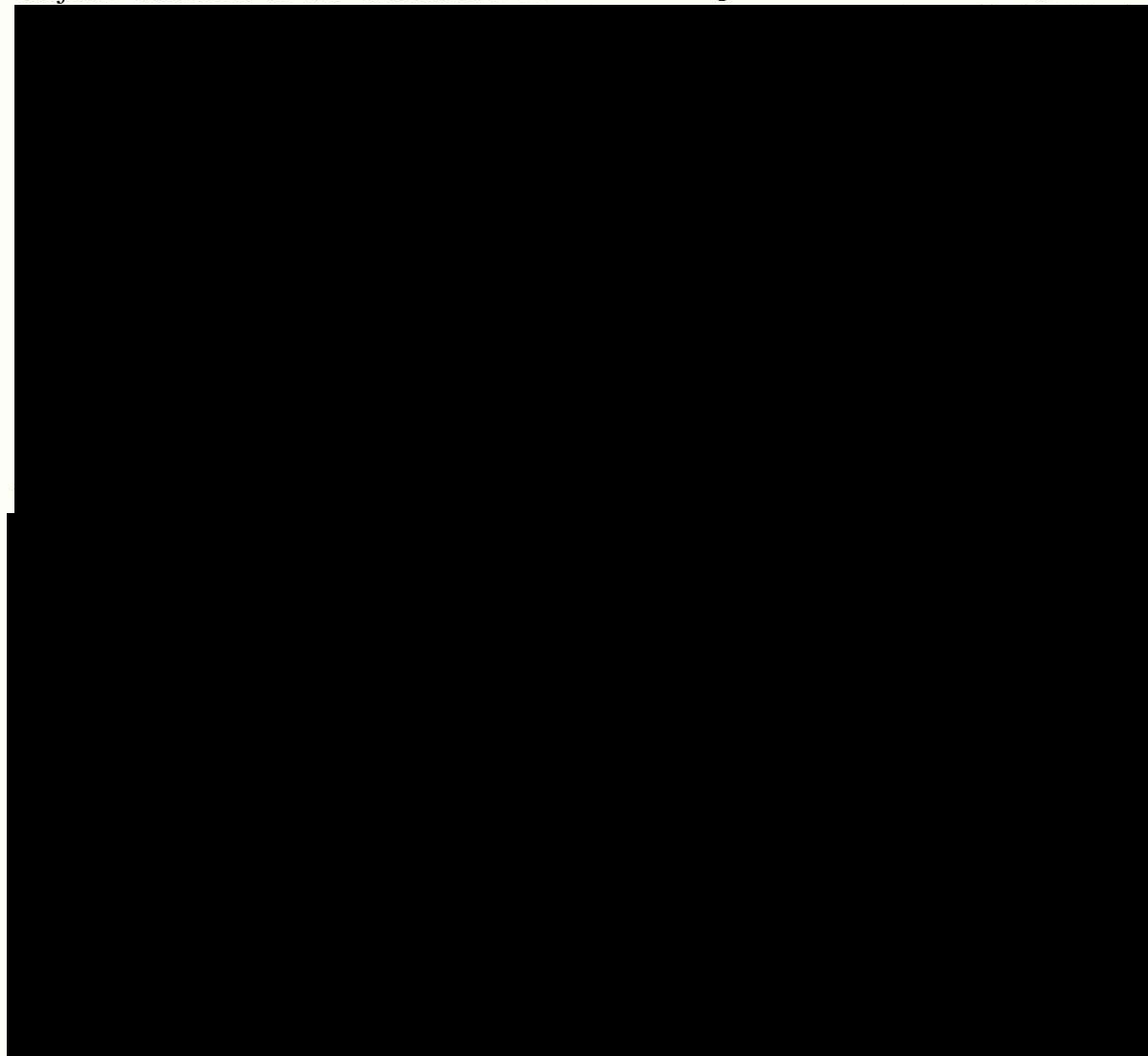


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 13555
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as **Innan Neb, coast batteries, barrage balloon site and camp** comprises the remains of four coastal artillery batteries with associated accommodation camps and ancillary structures, along with the remains of a barrage balloon site and two light anti-aircraft batteries. The site was used during the First and Second World War and forms part of a network of coastal batteries built to defend the key strategic British naval anchorage of Scapa Flow. It is located on the south coast of Flotta, overlooking the shipping channel through Switha Sound. The scheduled area is irregular on plan to include the remains described above and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction and use is expected to survive. The scheduling specifically excludes the upper 300mm of the roadway which passes through the site. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Walls and Flotta and the County of Orkney and Zetland as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects described in the aftermentioned deeds or registered in the Land Register of

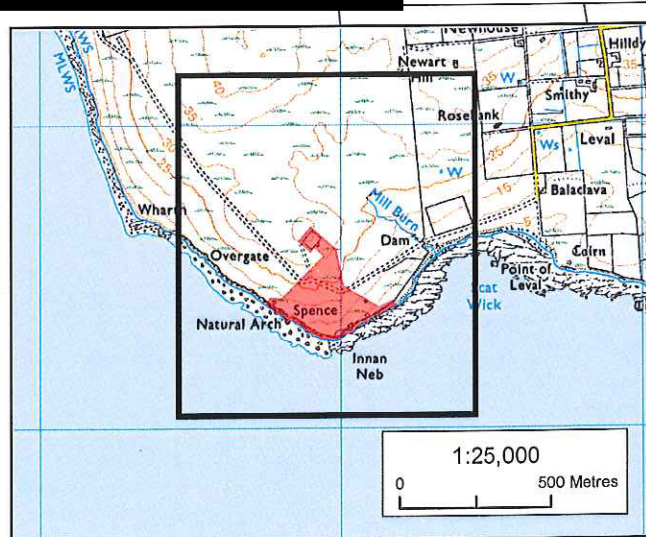
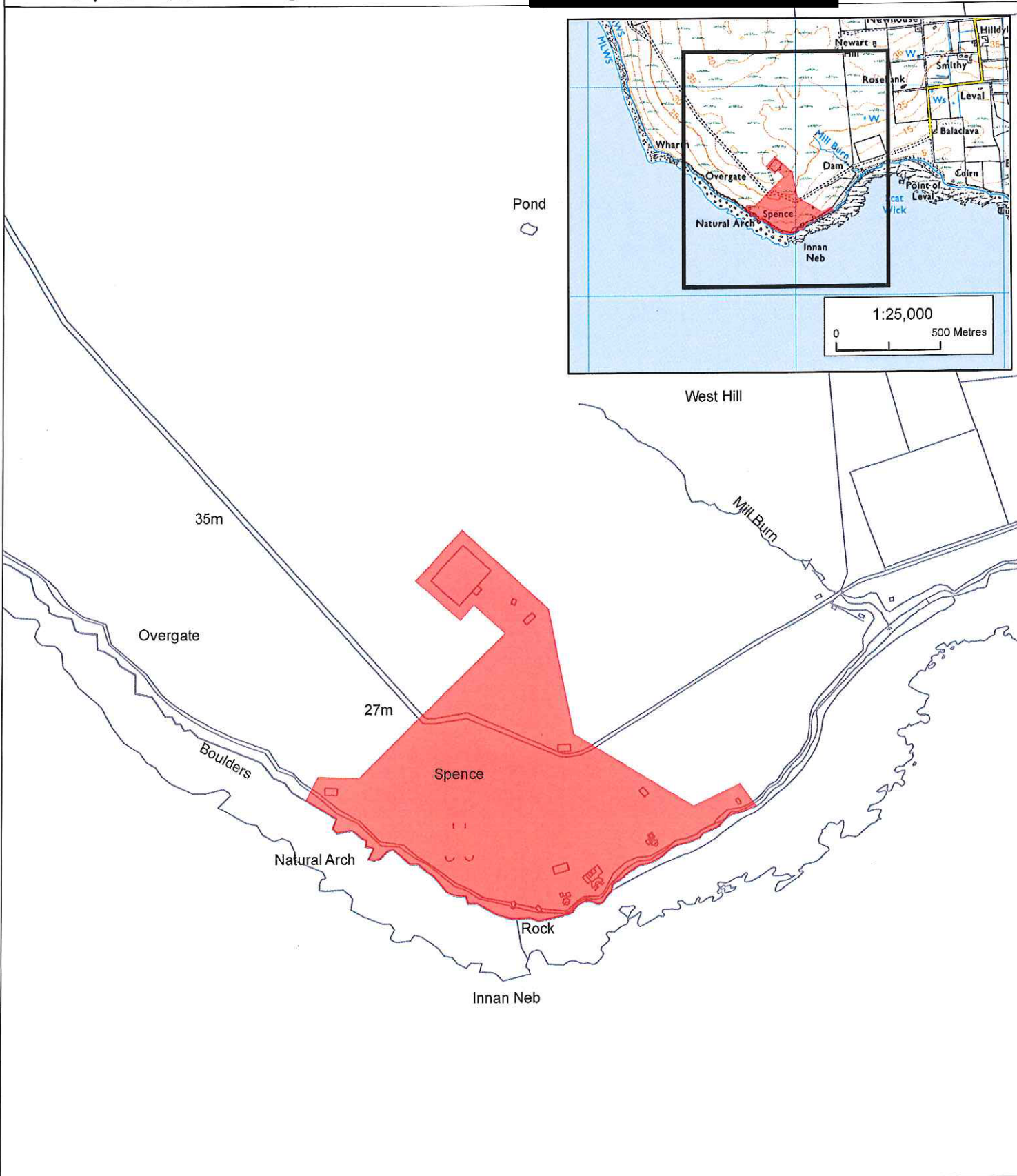
