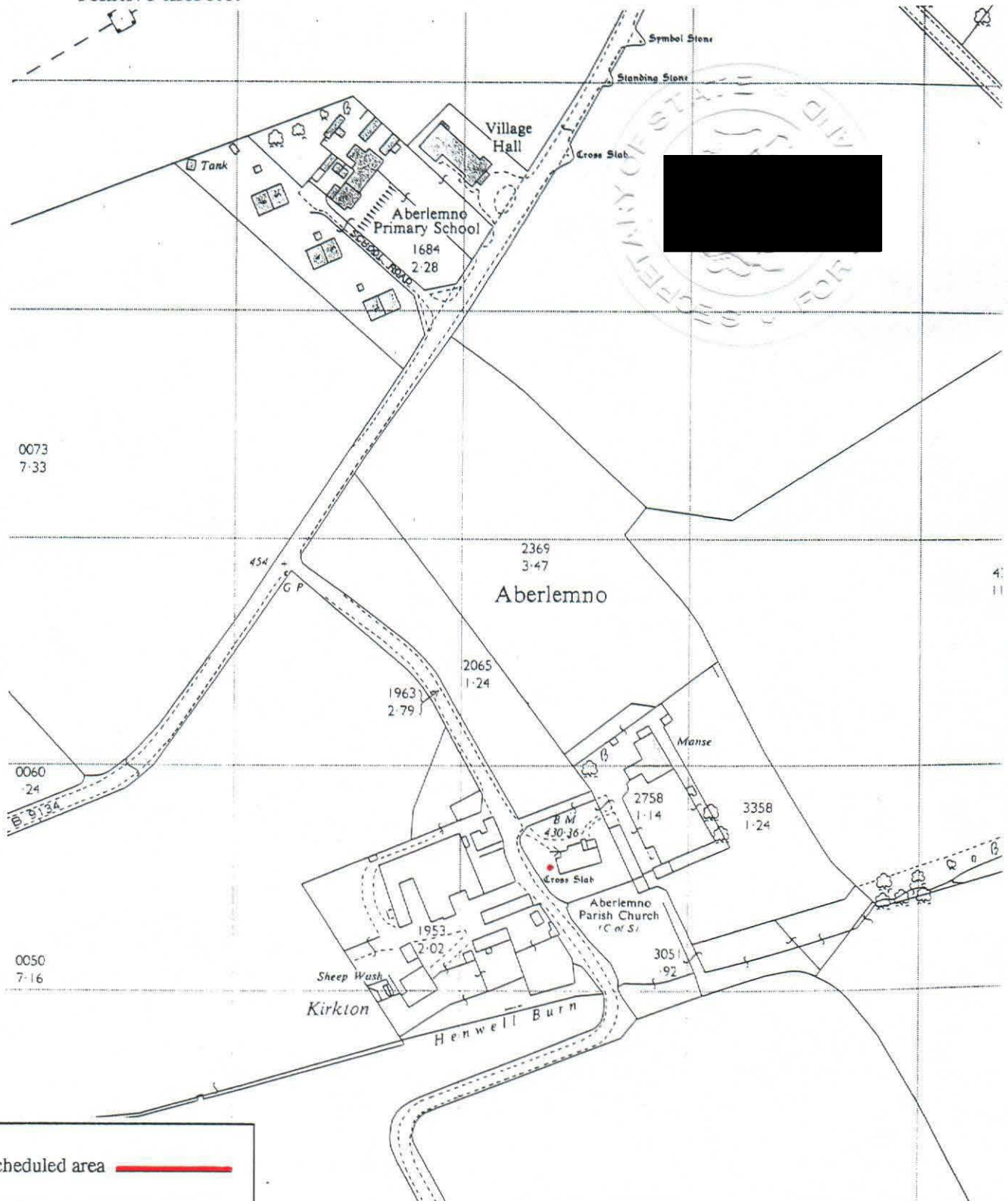

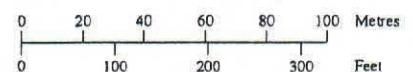
Aberlemno churchyard, cross slab
