ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Abernethy Round Tower and Pictish symbol stone comprises a medieval round tower, and a Pictish symbol stone. The area to be scheduled encompasses the remains described and an area around them in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is circular with a diameter of 8m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Abernethy and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

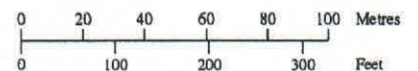
Abernethy Round Tower and Pictish symbol stone
