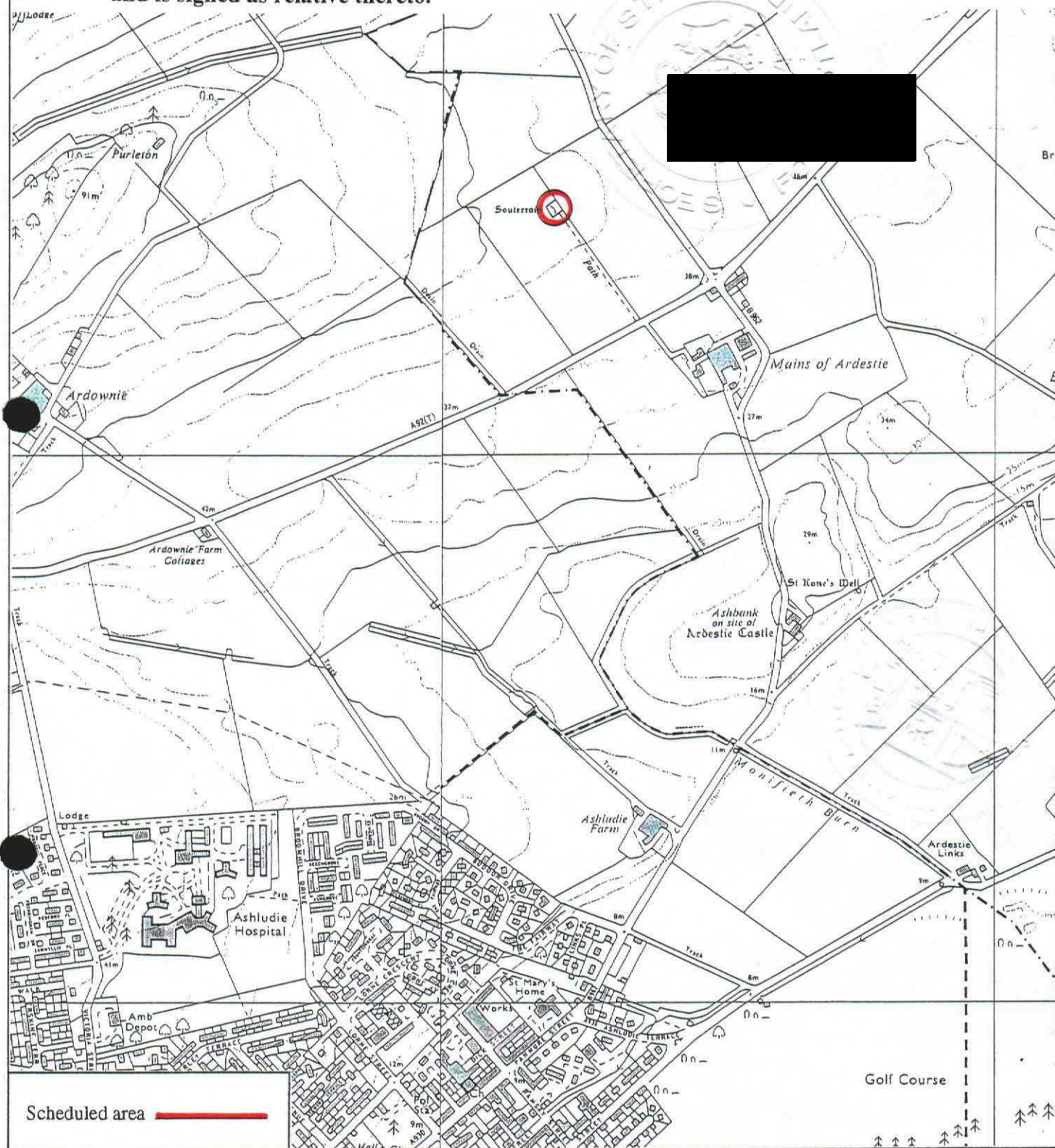

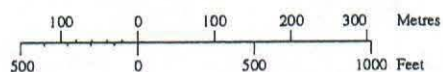
Ardestie, souterrain 400m NW of
