ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Auchengallon, cairn 150m WSW of, comprises a Bronze Age kerbed cairn (sometimes also described as a stone circle) which is situated on a slight W-facing terrace overlooking the N end of Machrie Bay. The area to be scheduled is almost circular on plan and measures up to 50m in diameter, to include the cairn and an area around in which associated remains may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmory and the County of Bute as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

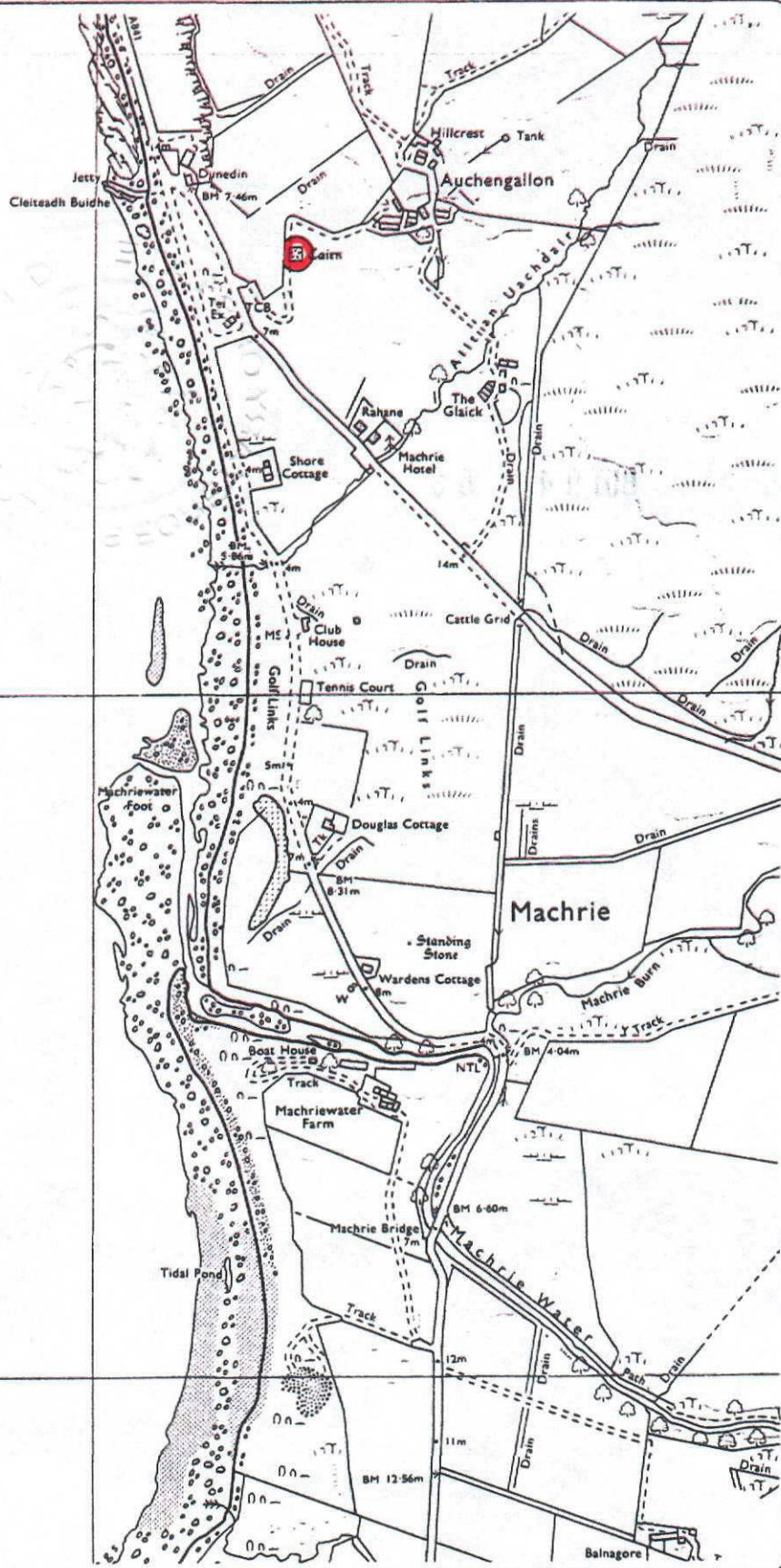

of

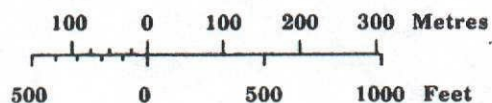
