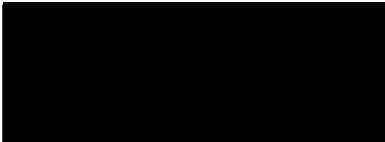
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Blackhammer, chambered cairn, Rousay comprises a Neolithic chambered burial cairn which is situated on a S-facing hillside. The area to be scheduled is rectangular and is contained within the fence surrounding the monument. It measures 30m E-W by 14m N-S. The boundary fence and concrete roof are included. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rousay and the County of Orkney as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

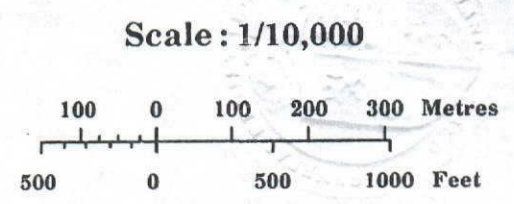
