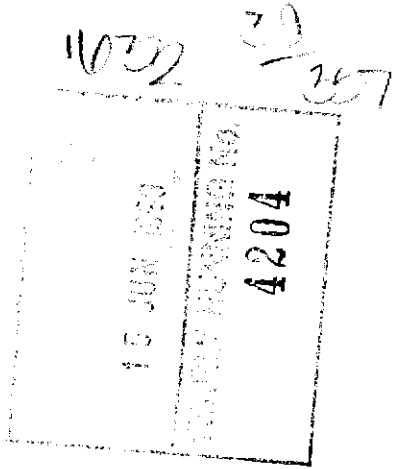

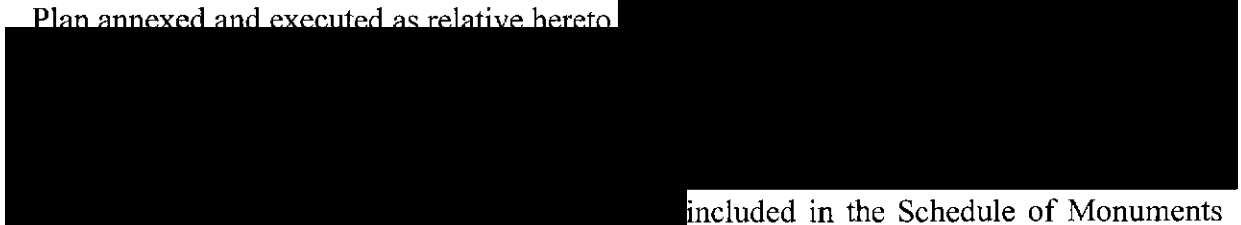

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Brandsbutt Stone, Symbol Stone comprises the Brandsbutt Symbol Stone, triangular in shape and measuring 1.07m high, 1.27m wide and 0.91m thick. The area to be scheduled is roughly trapezoidal, measuring some 8.7m along its N boundary, 10.8m on the SE, 7.9m on the W and 2m on the NW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Inverurie and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

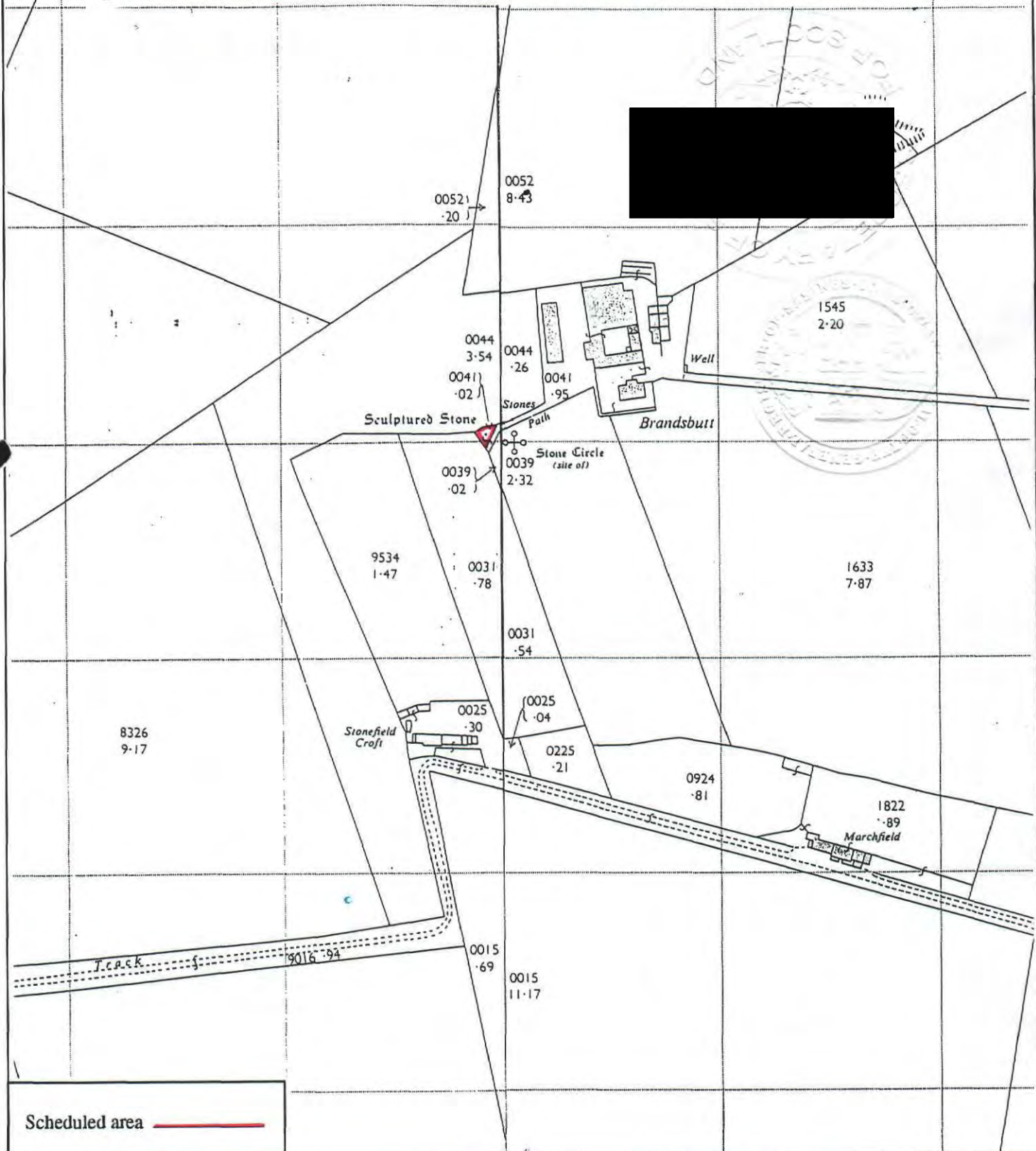

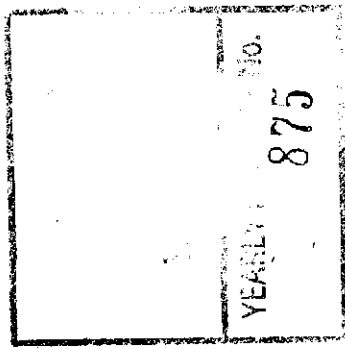

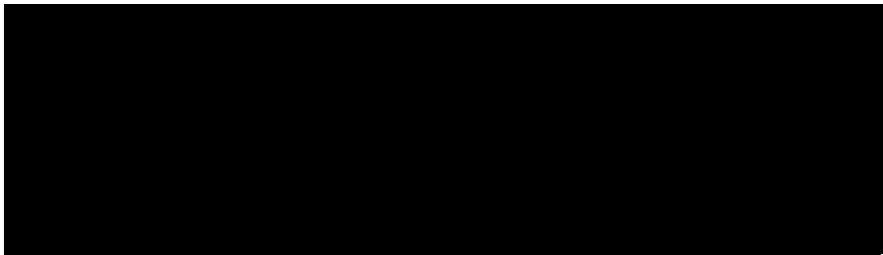
