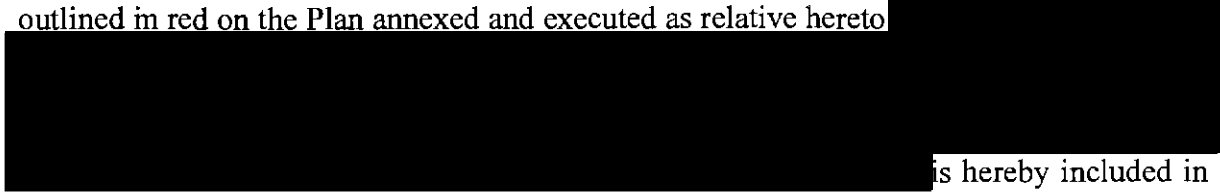

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Burghead Well comprises a rock-cut well. It comprises a rectangular chamber about 5m square and 3.8m high, with rounded angles, cut out of rock at the base of a crag. The area to be scheduled includes the well and the area around the site likely to contain associated archaeological evidence. It measures 30m NNE-SSW by 19m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Duffus and the County of Moray as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

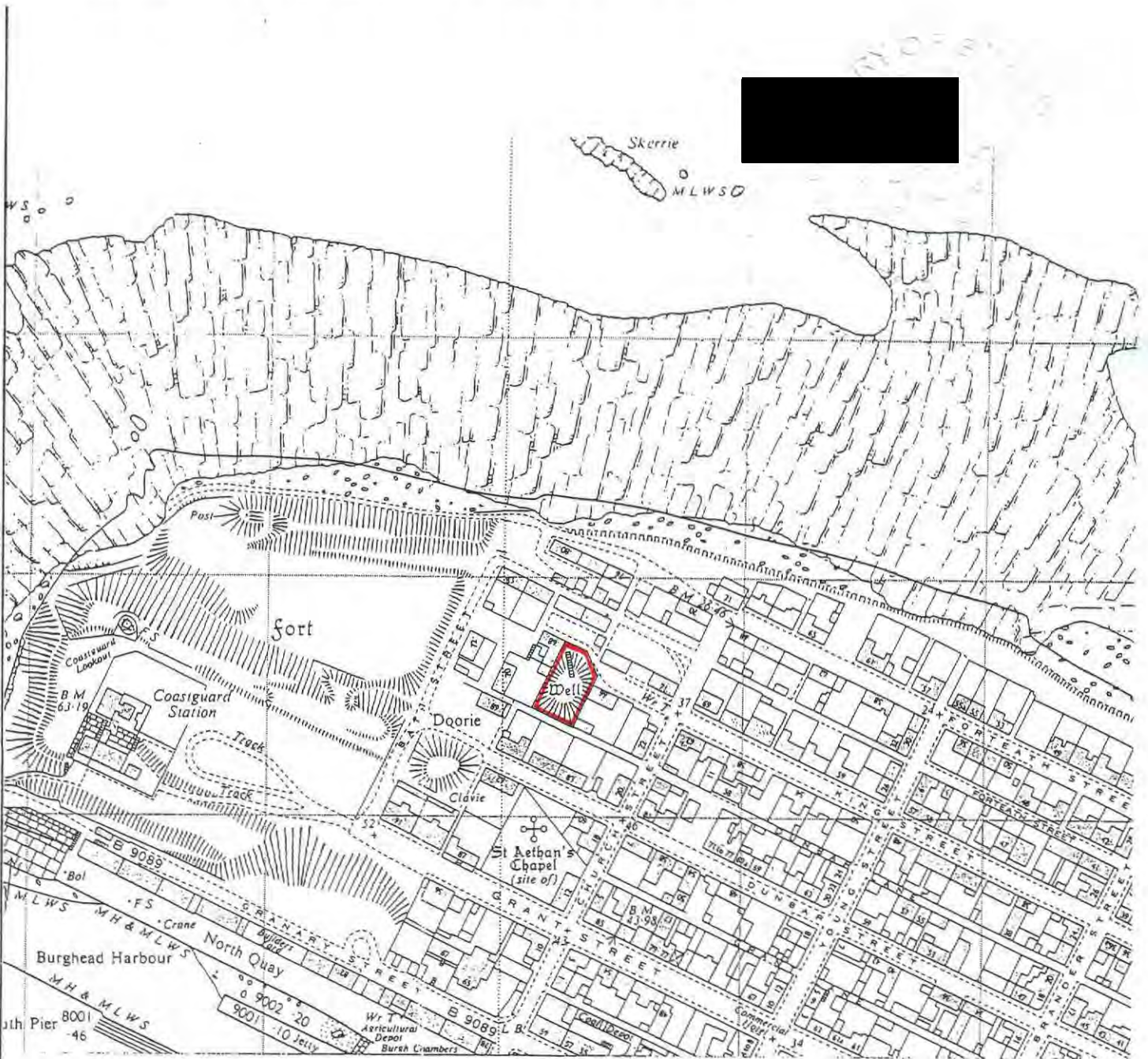
