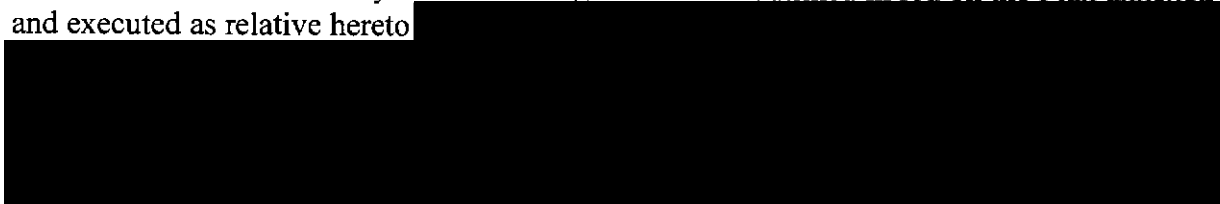

The monument known as Carsluith Castle, comprises the remains of Carsluith Castle, surviving as a substantial stone structure, along with the courtyard area to the front. Carsluith, now beside the A75, stands on a promontory in a commanding position overlooking Wigton Bay to the south, and protected by a natural ravine to the east. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described, together with the open courtyard to the north-east. It is sub-rectangular with maximum dimensions of 33m NE-SW by 22m E-W. The modern fences are excluded from the scheduling, as are the upper 250mm of all surfaced paths, yards and garden ground. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kirkmabreck and the County of Kirkcudbright as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

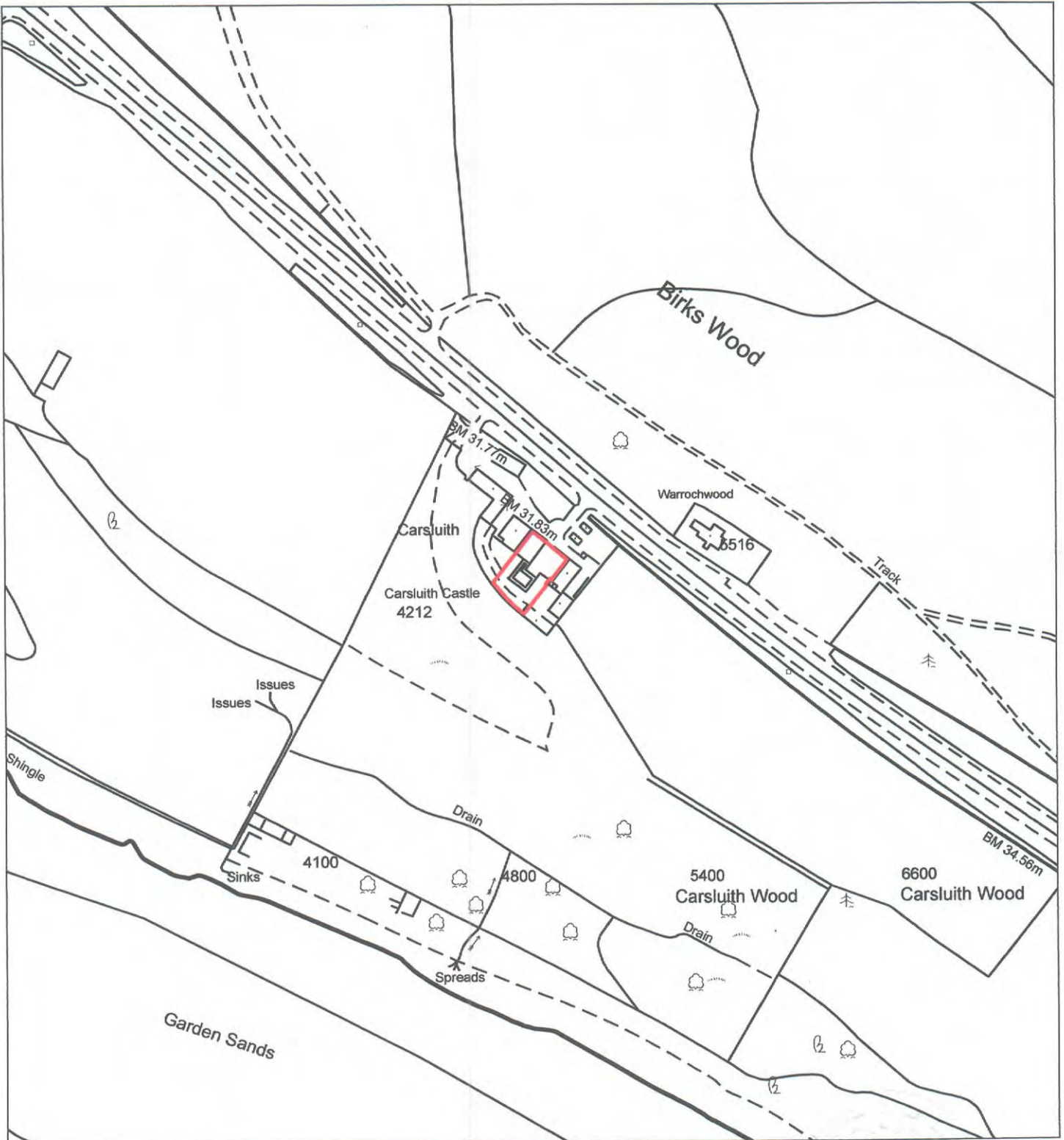
