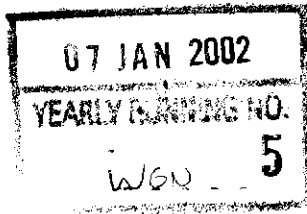

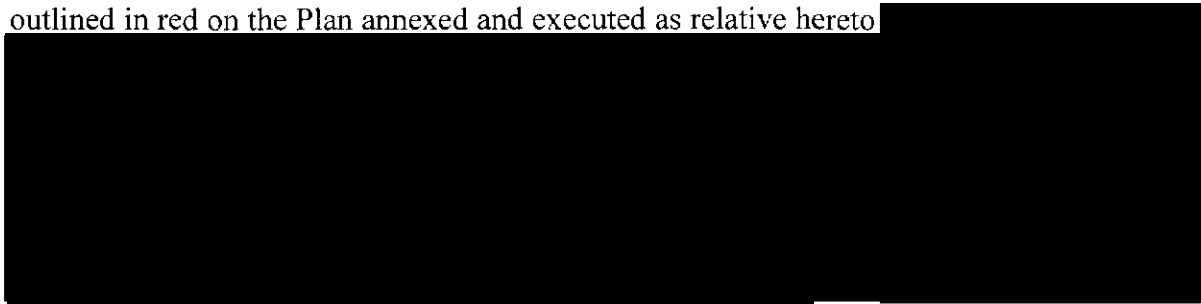

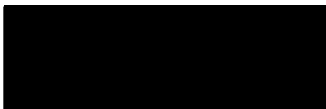
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Castle of Park, castle, Glenluce comprises the land around the castle which would originally have contained the barmkin, ancillary buildings and grounds associated with the tower house. The tower house itself is excluded from the scheduling. The area to be scheduled includes part of the gardens and areas around which are likely to have the potential to provide archaeological information on the use of the castle and its landscape. It is irregular, with maximum dimensions of 40m due E-W by 60m due N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Glenluce and the County of Wigtown as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

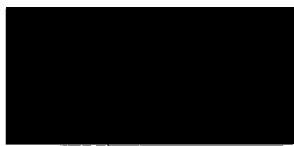

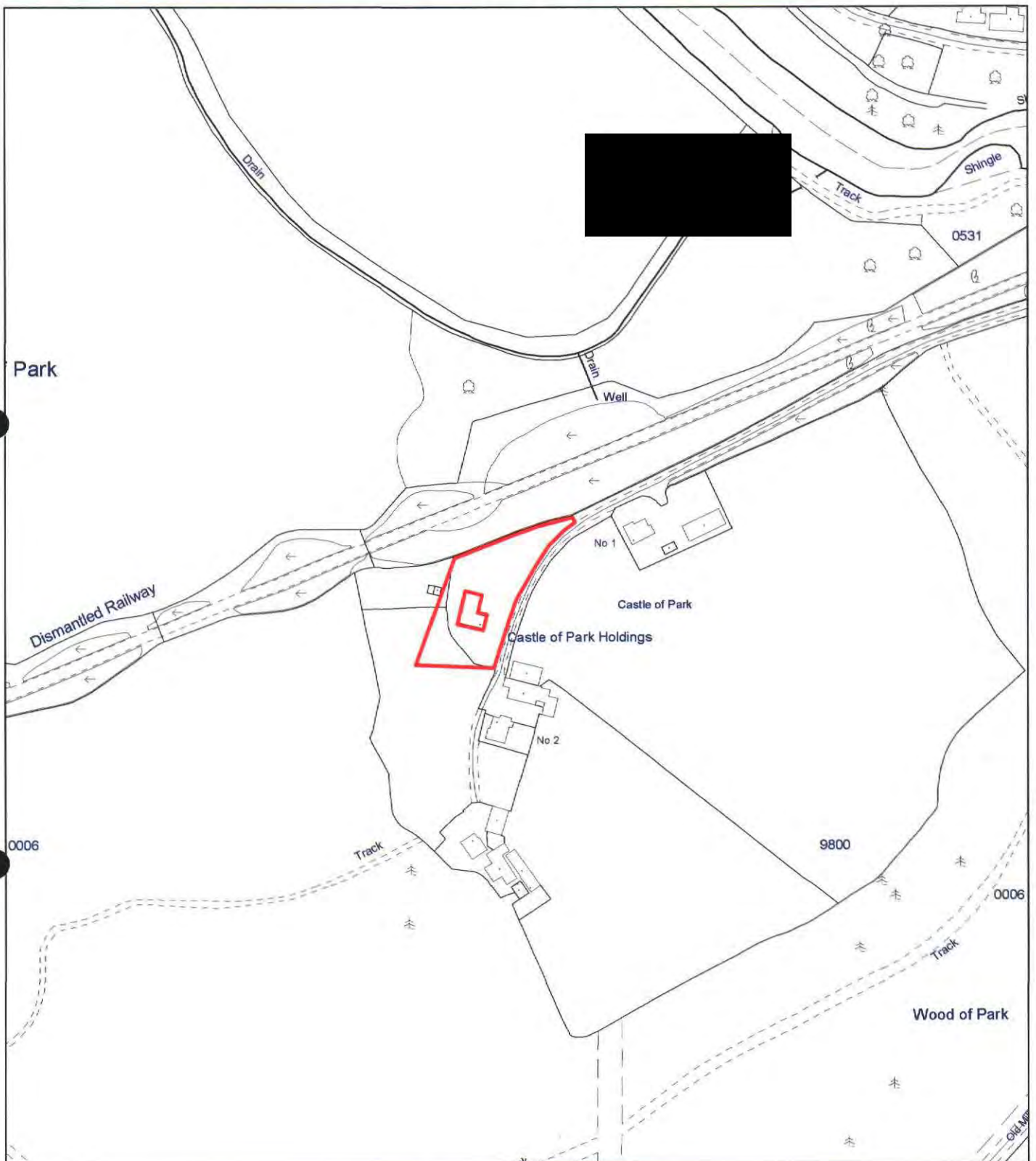
