THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as The Chesters, fort, Drem comprises a multivallate fort of later prehistoric date surviving as a series of earthworks. It is one of the best preserved examples of this class of monument in Scotland. The area to be scheduled encompasses the visible features and an area round them to the NE and E in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. In order to include fully the areas of high archaeological sensitivity the scheduled area exceeds the existing Guardianship area. The area to be scheduled is irregular in shape with maximum dimensions of 370m E-W by 190m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Athelstaneford and the County of East Lothian as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

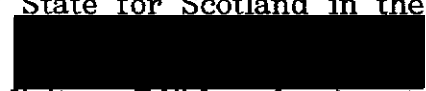

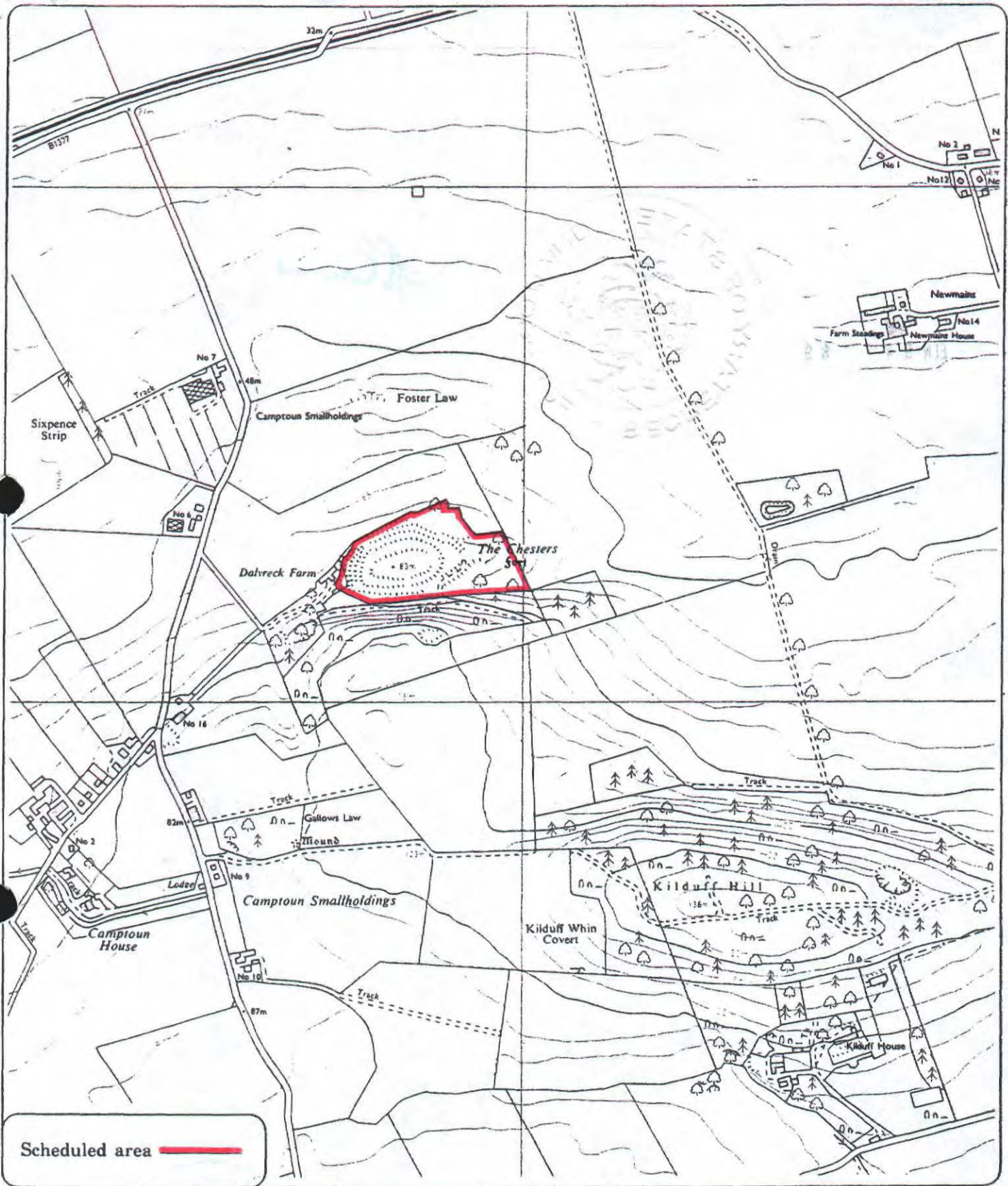

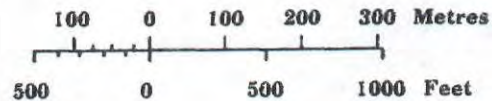
