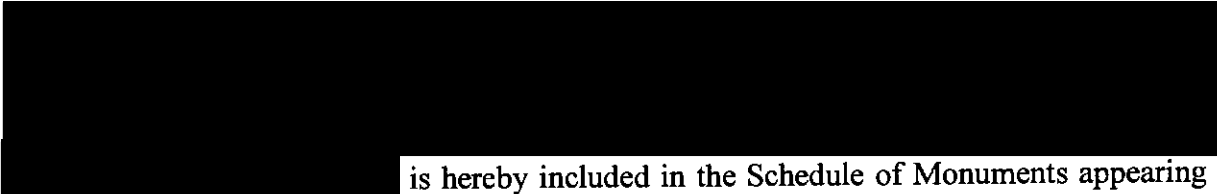

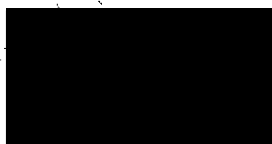

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Claypotts Castle comprises the remains of Claypotts Castle which stands on the eastern periphery of Dundee. The area to be scheduled encompasses the castle itself and the surrounding area in the care of the Secretary of State, in which traces of associated outbuildings, and archaeological deposits relating to activity around the castle, may be expected to survive. It is irregular in shape with maximum dimensions of 60m NE-SW by 40m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Dundee and the County of Angus as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

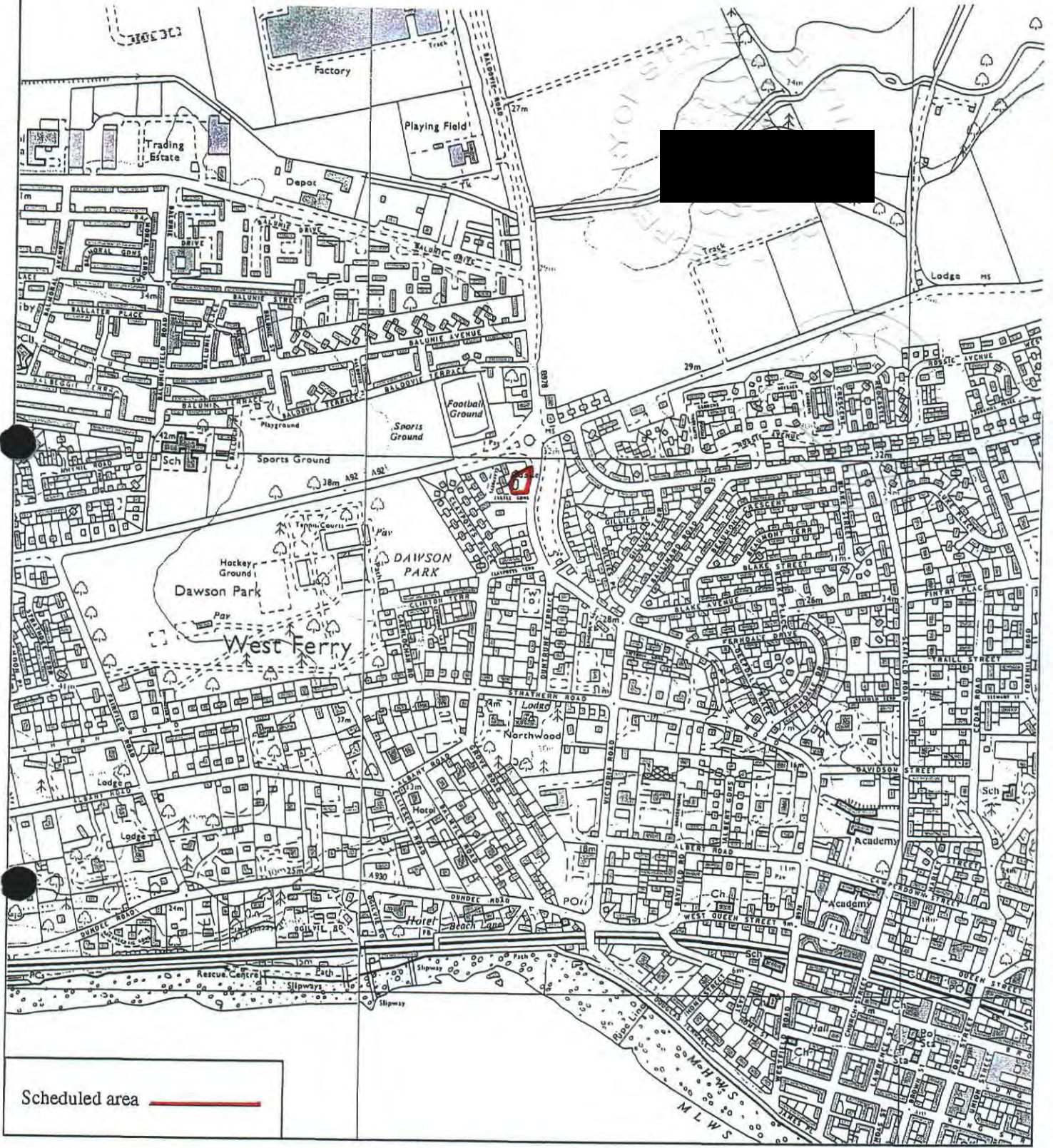

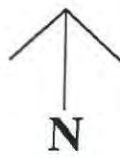

Scheduled area

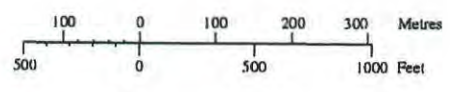
Claypotts Castle
