ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Click Mill, 500m ESE of Eastabist, Dounby comprises a horizontal mill, or "click mill" and associated structures. The area to be scheduled includes the mill, lade, bridge and the fence enclosing them, representing a kite-shaped area of ground measuring some 27.5m on the E, 12m on the SE, 16m on the SW and 25.3m on the NW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Birsay and Harray and the County of Orkney as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

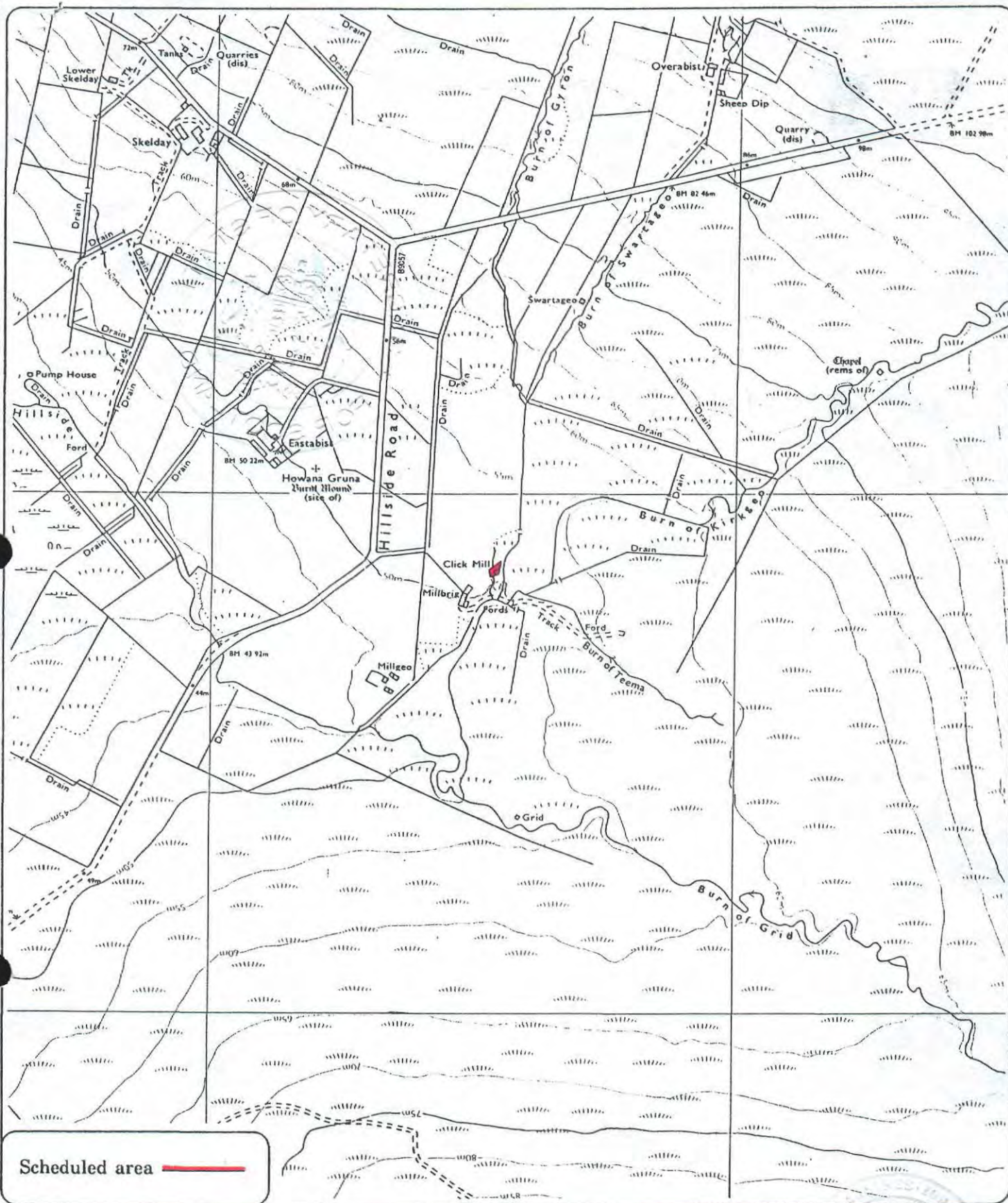

Eastabist, Dounby

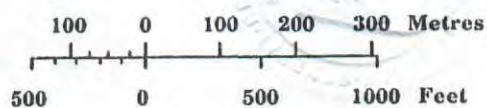
