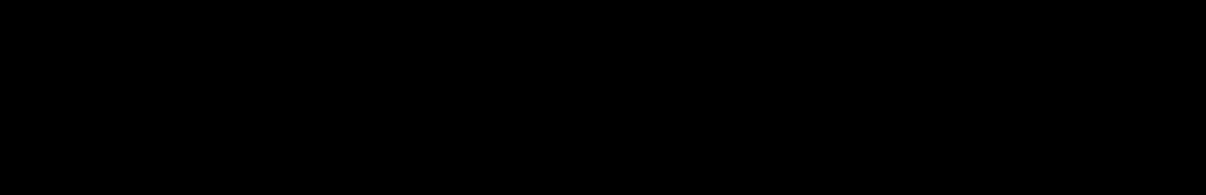

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Clickimin Broch, broch and settlement comprises the broch of Clickimin. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, bounded to the S by the fence marking the limit of the area in state care and on the remainder of the perimeter by a line running approximately 20m out from the edge of the peninsula on which the monument stands, so that a portion of the bed of the loch is included. Within this area evidence relating to the construction and use of the various elements of the monument is likely to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Lerwick and the County of Shetland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

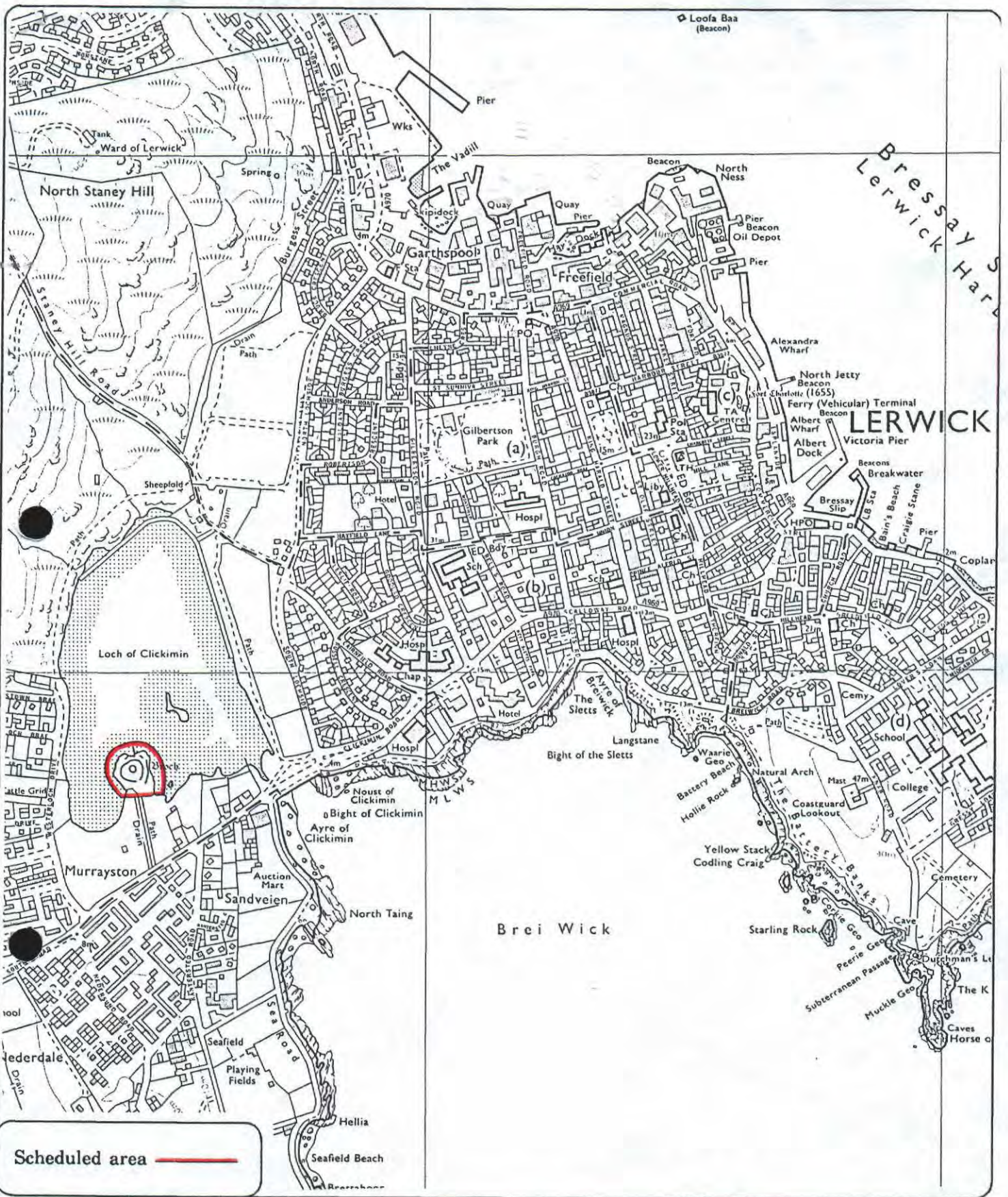

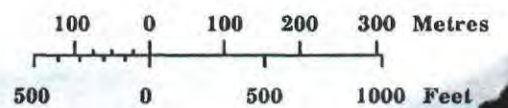
**Clickimin Broch, broch and settlement**
