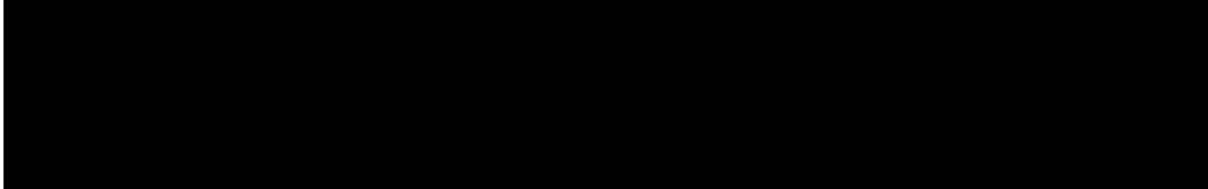

The monument known as Cobbie Row's Castle comprises a castle of early medieval date. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is circular with a diameter of 70m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rousay and Egilsay and the County of Orkney as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

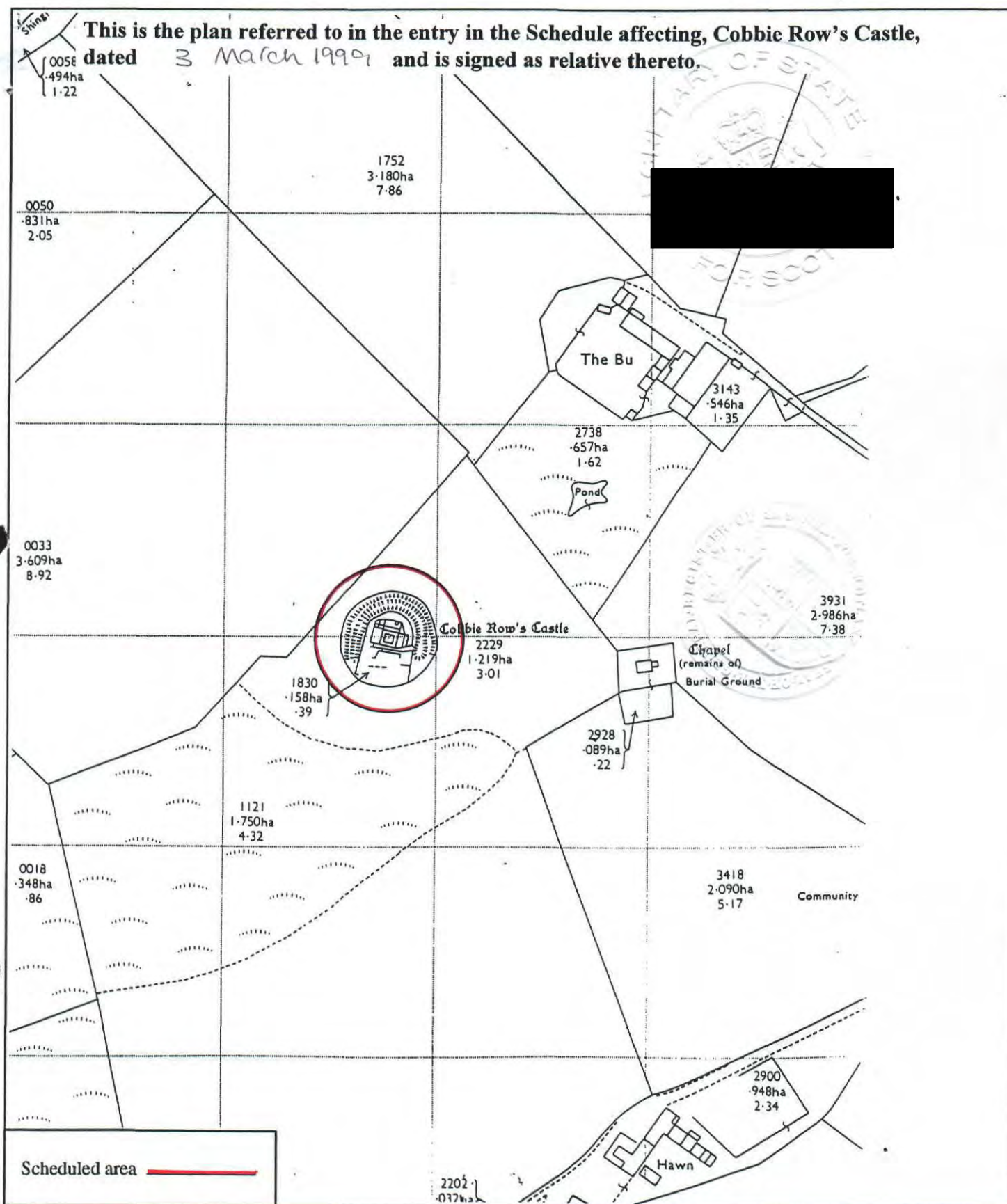
