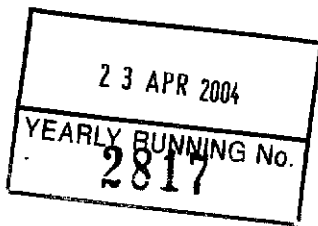

The monument known as Crossraguel Abbey, comprises the extensive remains of the 13th century Cluniac Abbey of Crossraguel, surviving as substantial stone structures, as earthworks and as buried archaeology, together with an area likely to contain part of the outer precinct. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is larger than that of the property in the care of the Scottish Ministers. The area is irregular with maximum dimensions of 237m NE-SW by 292m WNW-ESE. The modern fences are excluded from the scheduling, as are the upper 300mm of all surfaced paths, roads and the car park. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kirkoswald and the County of Ayr as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

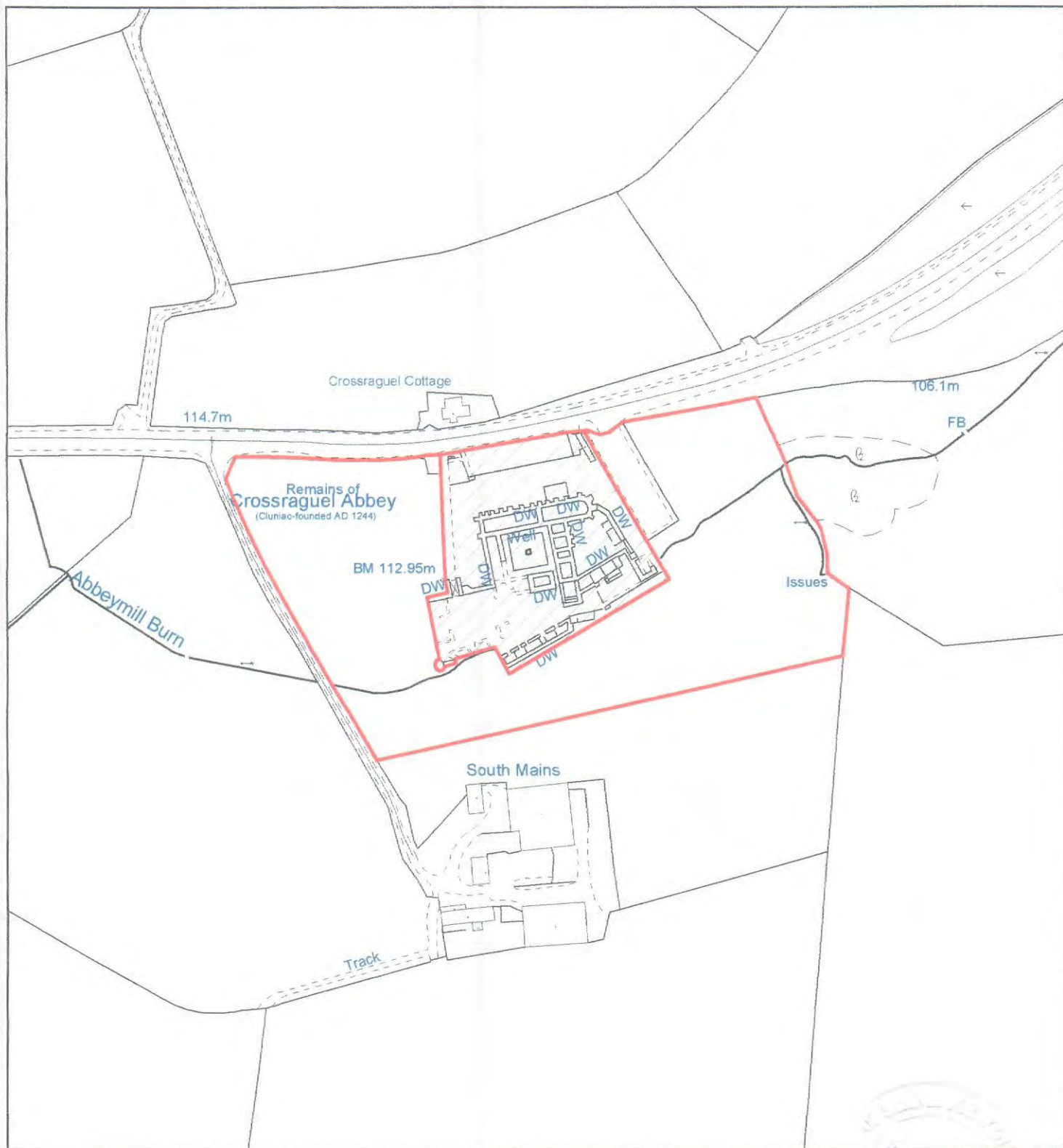
