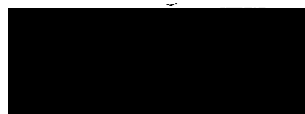
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Duffus, St Peter's Church and Churchyard comprises a church, burial ground and watch house of post-Reformation date, and a cross of late medieval date. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is defined on the E, S and W by the outside face of the stone boundary wall, on the N by the road verge and on the NE by a fence. The area measures overall 100m N-S by 68m E-W. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Duffus and the County of Elgin as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

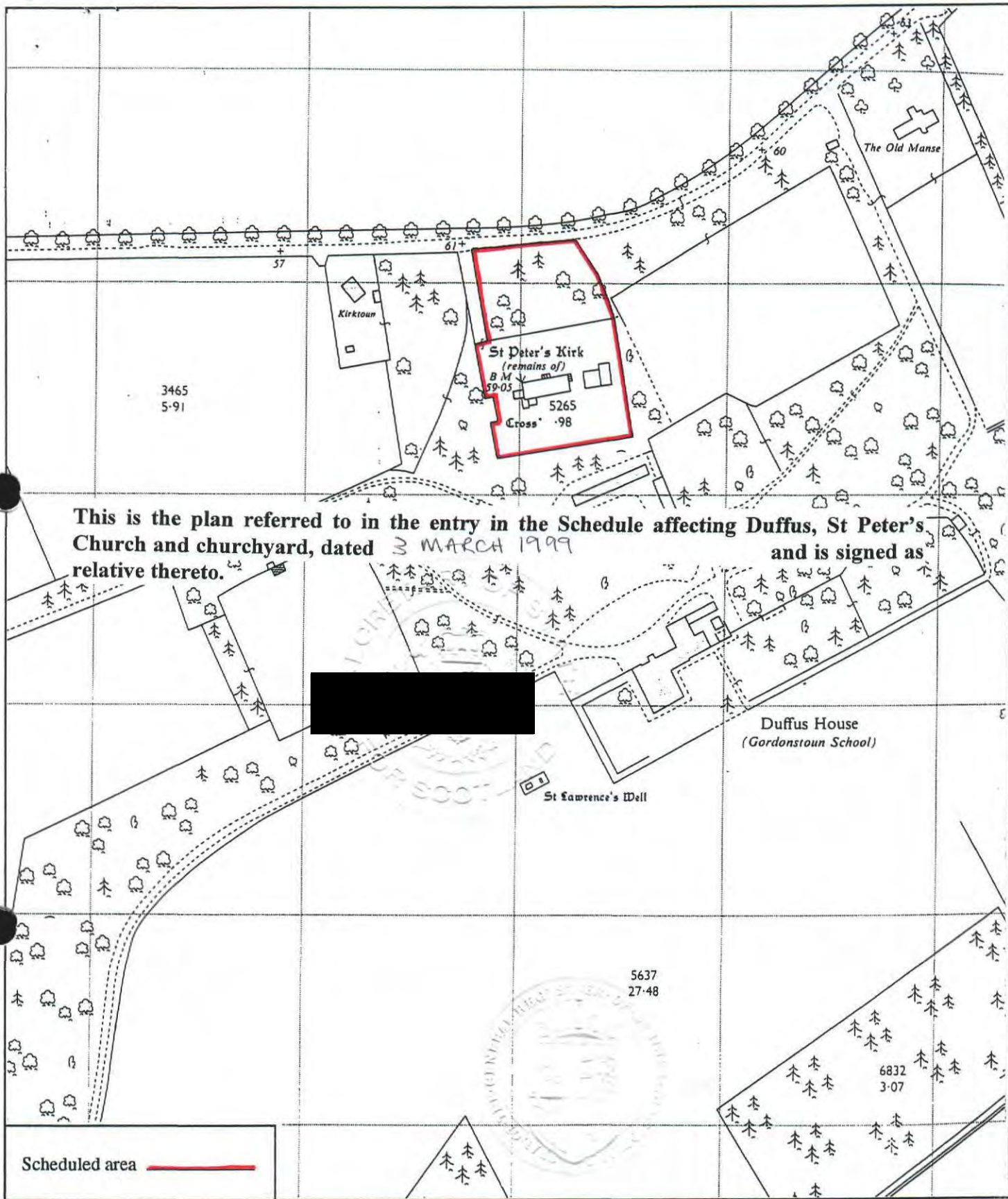

Scheduled area

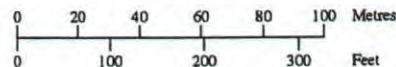
Duffus, St Peter's Church and churchyard
