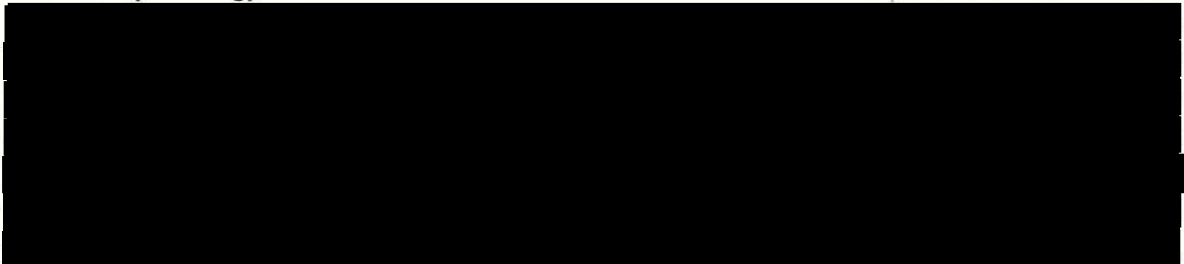


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 90108
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as **Dunadd, fort, boar carving, ogam inscription and cupmarkings** comprises a high-status Early Historic fort and associated carvings, situated on an isolated rocky massif above the boggy flats of Moine Mhor, adjacent to the River Add. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan and measures up to 280m from WSW to ENE by up to 210m, to include the fort, carvings and area around in which associated remains may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmichael Glassary and the County of Argyll as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

This entry supersedes the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments for the monument known then as **Dunadd, fort, boar carving, ogam inscription and cupmarkings** as referred to in the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments by The Secretary of State for Scotland in respect of the monument dated 31 May 1994 and recorded in the General Register of Sasines for the County of Argyll on 17 August 1994.

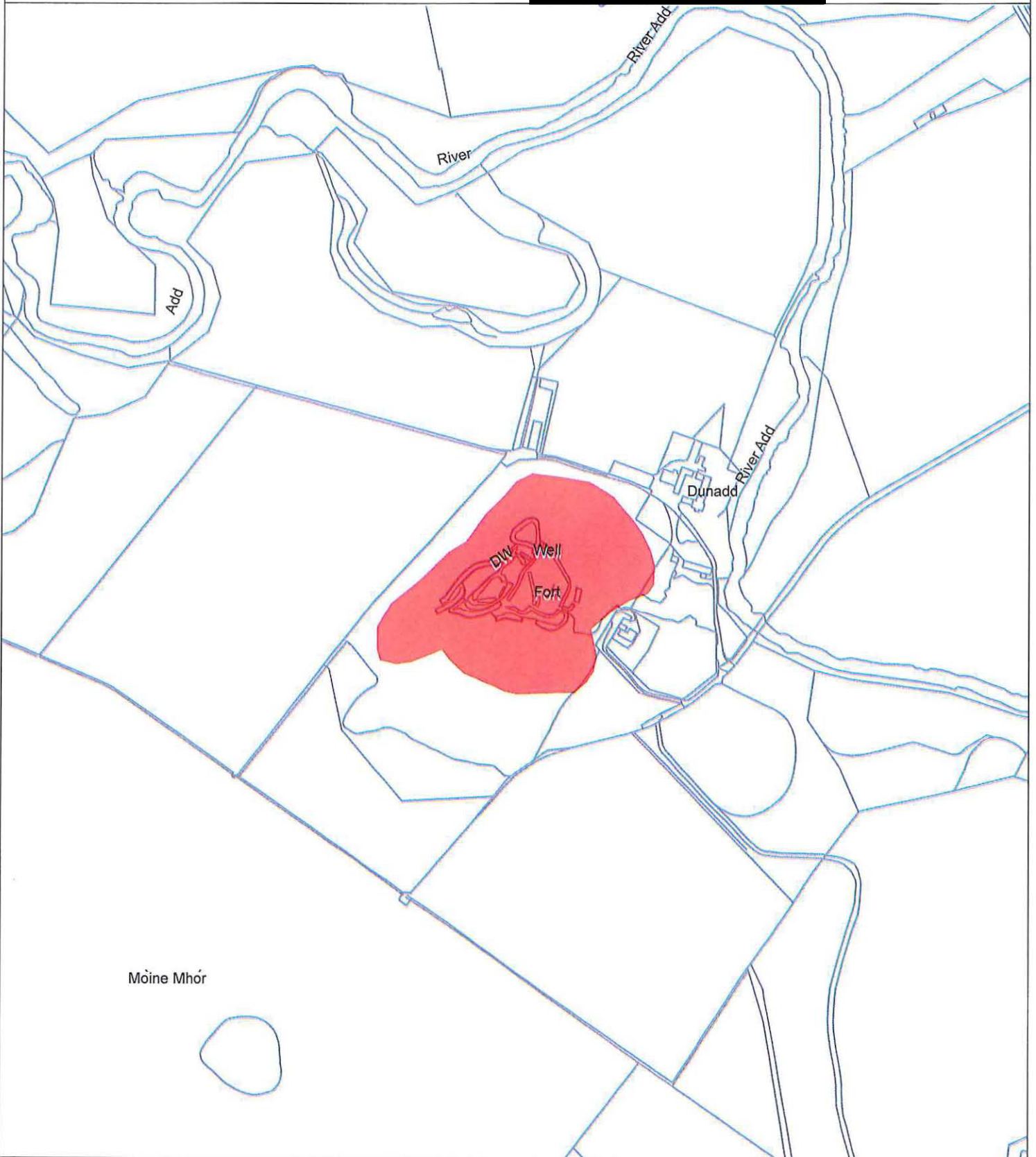
