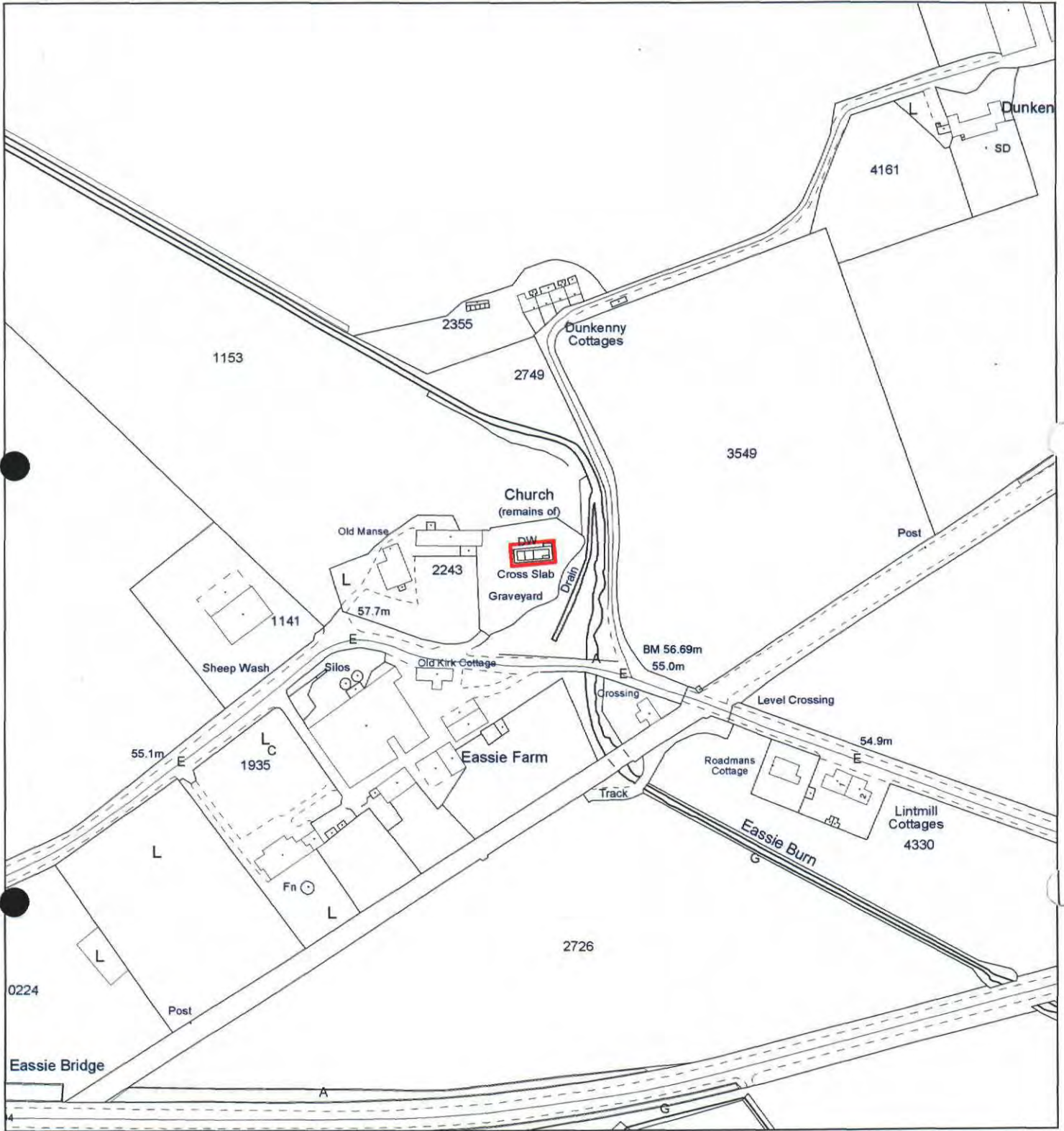
The monument known as Eassie Old Church and cross slab comprises the remains of a cross slab of Pictish date and Eassie Old Church. The cross slab which is a Class II symbol stone is set within a modern protective shelter in the corner of the church. The carvings on the stone are all typical motifs of the Pictish, or Early Historic period. Eassie Church is rectangular. The northern and southern walls stand to a height of about 2m and the gables are complete. The church was extensively remodelled in the 16th century. The W doorway appears to be an insertion of the 18th century. The area to be scheduled encompasses the church and cross slab and an area around them within which related material may be expected to survive. It is rectangular, measuring 20m ENE-WSW by 10m transversely. All burial lairs, where burial rights still exist are excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Eassie and Nevay and the County of Angus as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

Scheduled Area

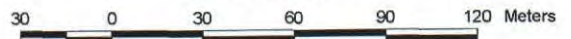
