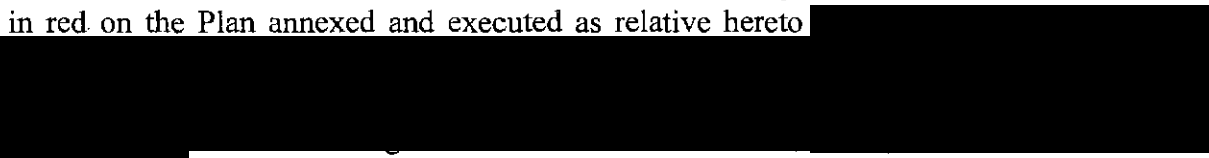

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Edin's Hall, broch, fort and settlement comprises a fort, broch and settlement of prehistoric date. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is irregular, with maximum dimensions of 210m from its easternmost point to its westernmost point and 170m from its northernmost point to its southernmost point. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Duns and the County of Berwick as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

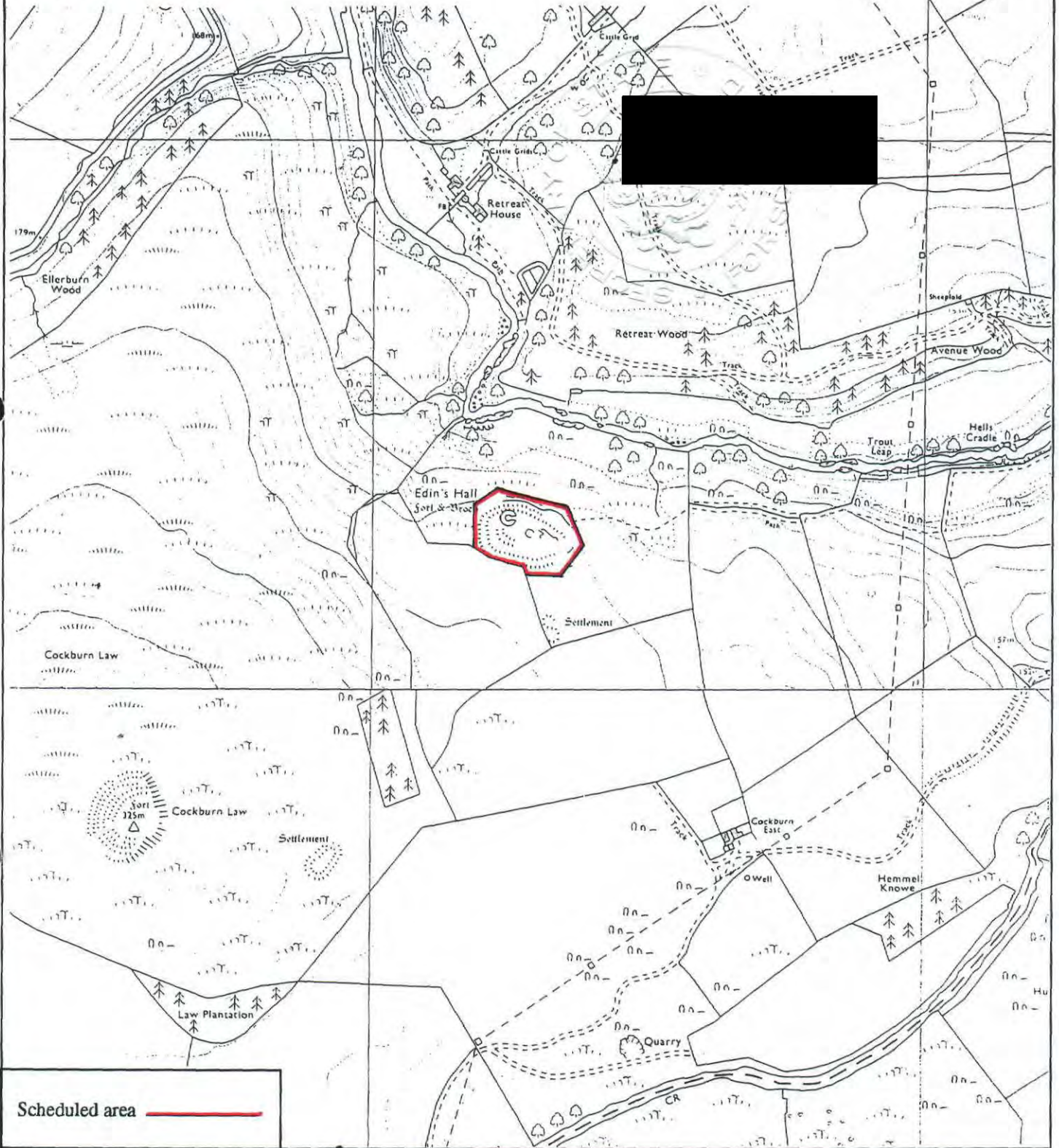


Scheduled area
