ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Eileach-an-Naoimh, monastery, Garvellachs comprises the extensive remains of a monastery originating in the pre-Norse period. The site is very complex, incorporating a pair of interconnecting beehive cells, two church structures, two burial grounds, a burial cairn, boat landing and numerous related and later structures. The area to be scheduled includes all the features noted above. It is defined to the SE by the highwater mark and to the NW by the edge of the cliffs which run up the NW side of the island. To the NE and SW the area is defined by two lines running NW-SE. The first runs 50m SW of the SW burial ground and the second 70m NE of the corn kiln. The area measures 510m from its northernmost to its southernmost point by 490m from its easternmost to its westernmost point. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Jura and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

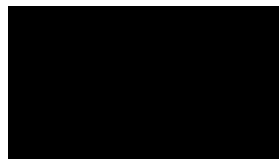

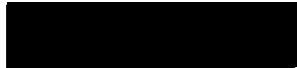

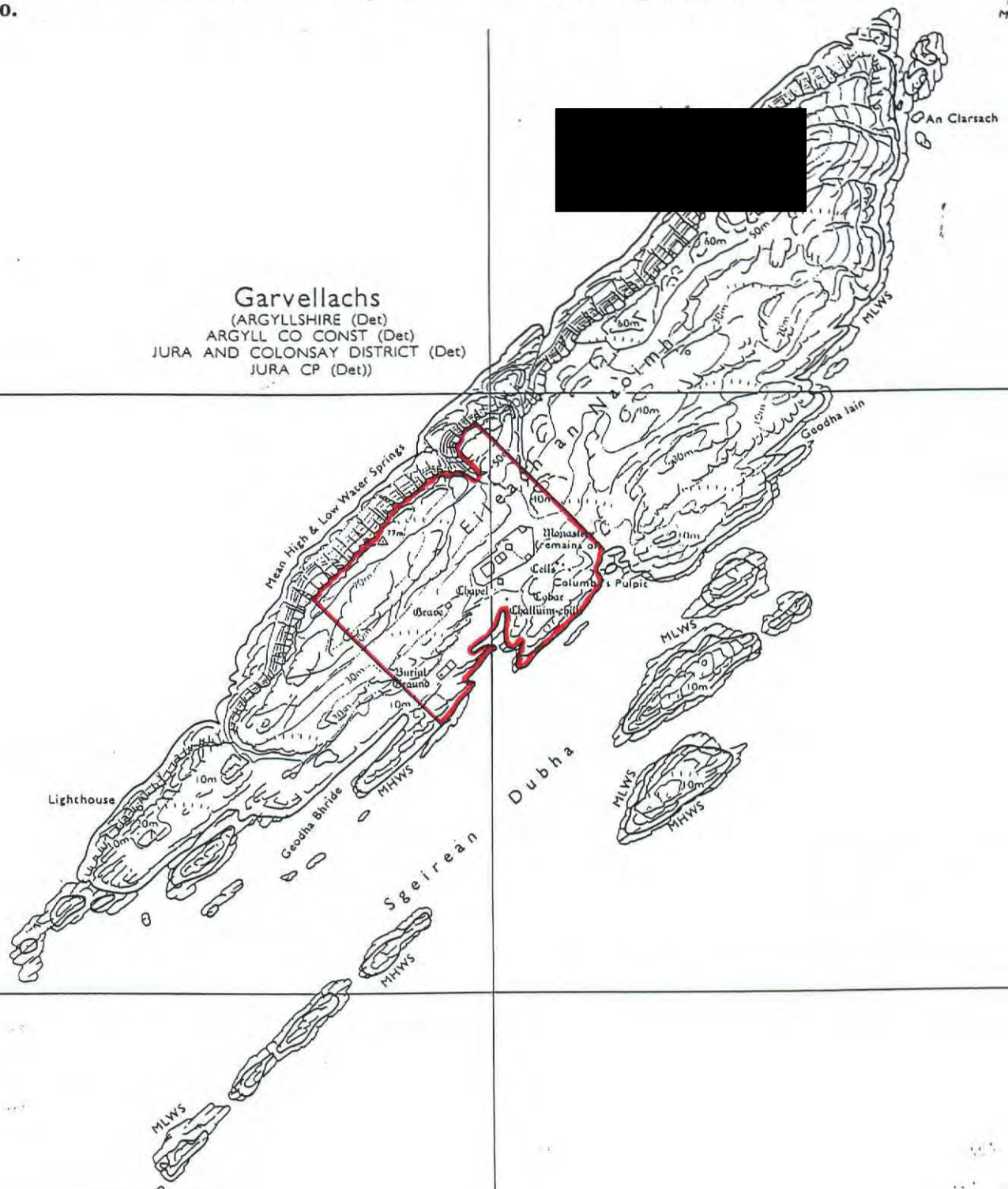

Scheduled area

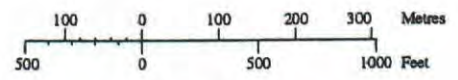
