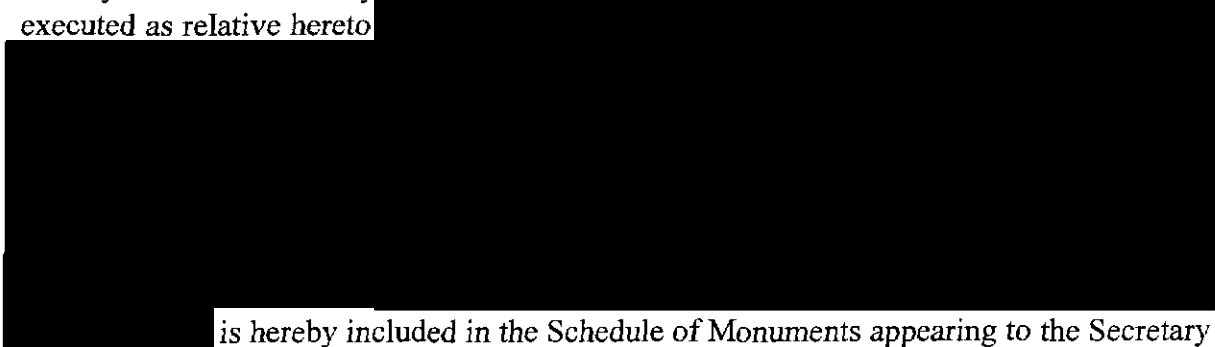

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Elcho Castle comprises Elcho Castle, its associated structures and immediate environs. The area to be scheduled encompasses the remains described above and an area around them within which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is irregular in shape with maximum dimensions of 95m N-S by 174m E-W. Above-ground structures associated with the custodians house, toilet block and modern field boundaries are excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rhynd and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

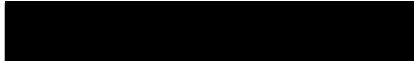
