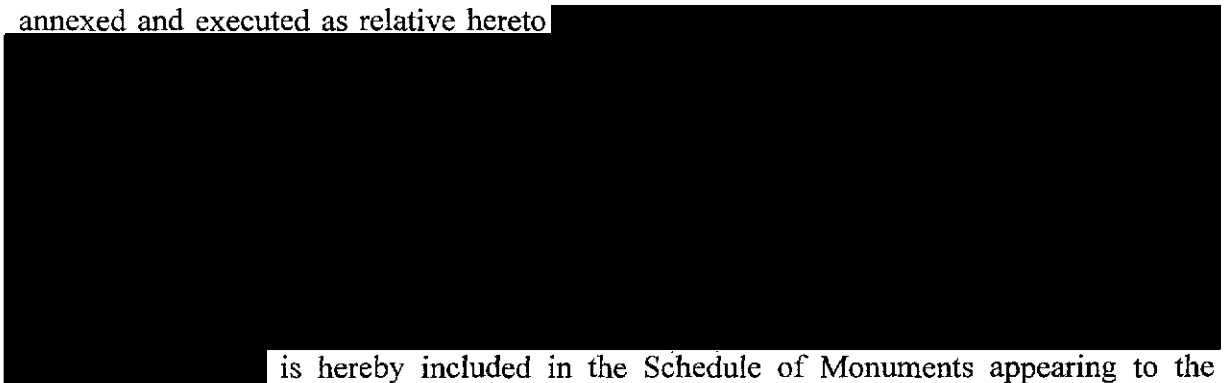

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Foulden Old Tithe Barn comprises an 18th- or early 19th-century barn and its courtyard adjacent to the church whose teinds or tithes were stored in it. The area to be scheduled includes the barn and the courtyard to the E of it, is irregular on plan and measures a maximum of 26m E-W by 17m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Foulden and the County of Roxburgh as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

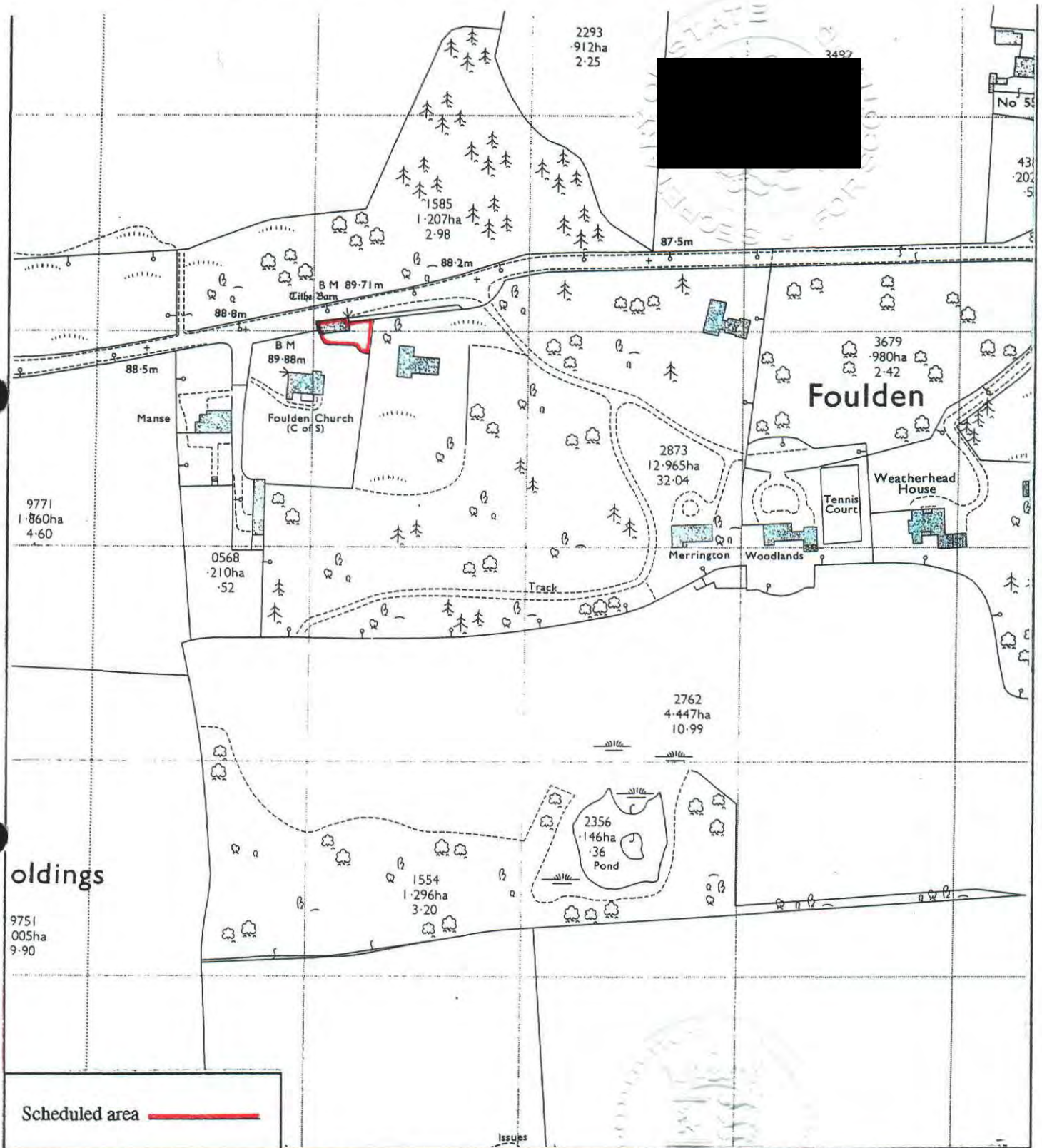

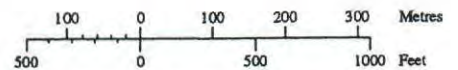
