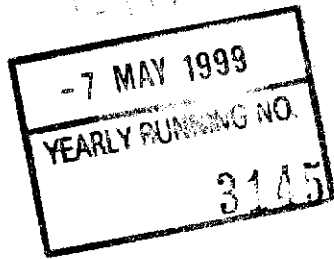

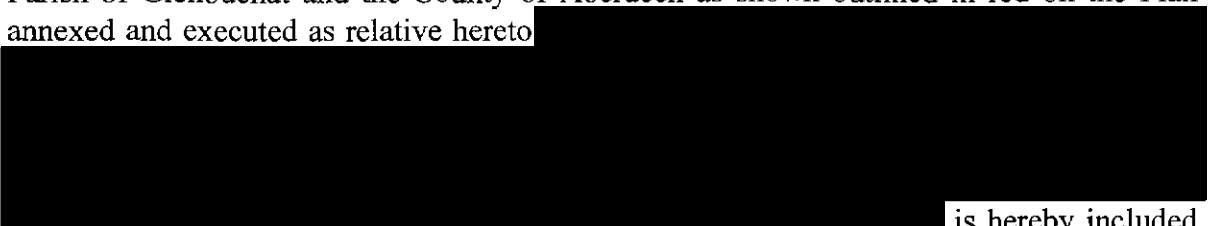

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Glenbuchat Castle comprises the remains of Glenbuchat Castle and a surrounding area of land representing part of the policies. The monument to be scheduled includes the castle itself and an irregular area of enclosed land adjoining it on the N, NE, S and W, measuring overall some 2m E-W by 112m N-S. The enclosed car park area NE of the castle and all boundary walls and fences surrounding the scheduled area dependent on the castle are excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Glenbuchat and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

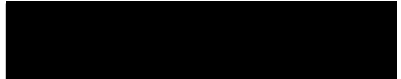

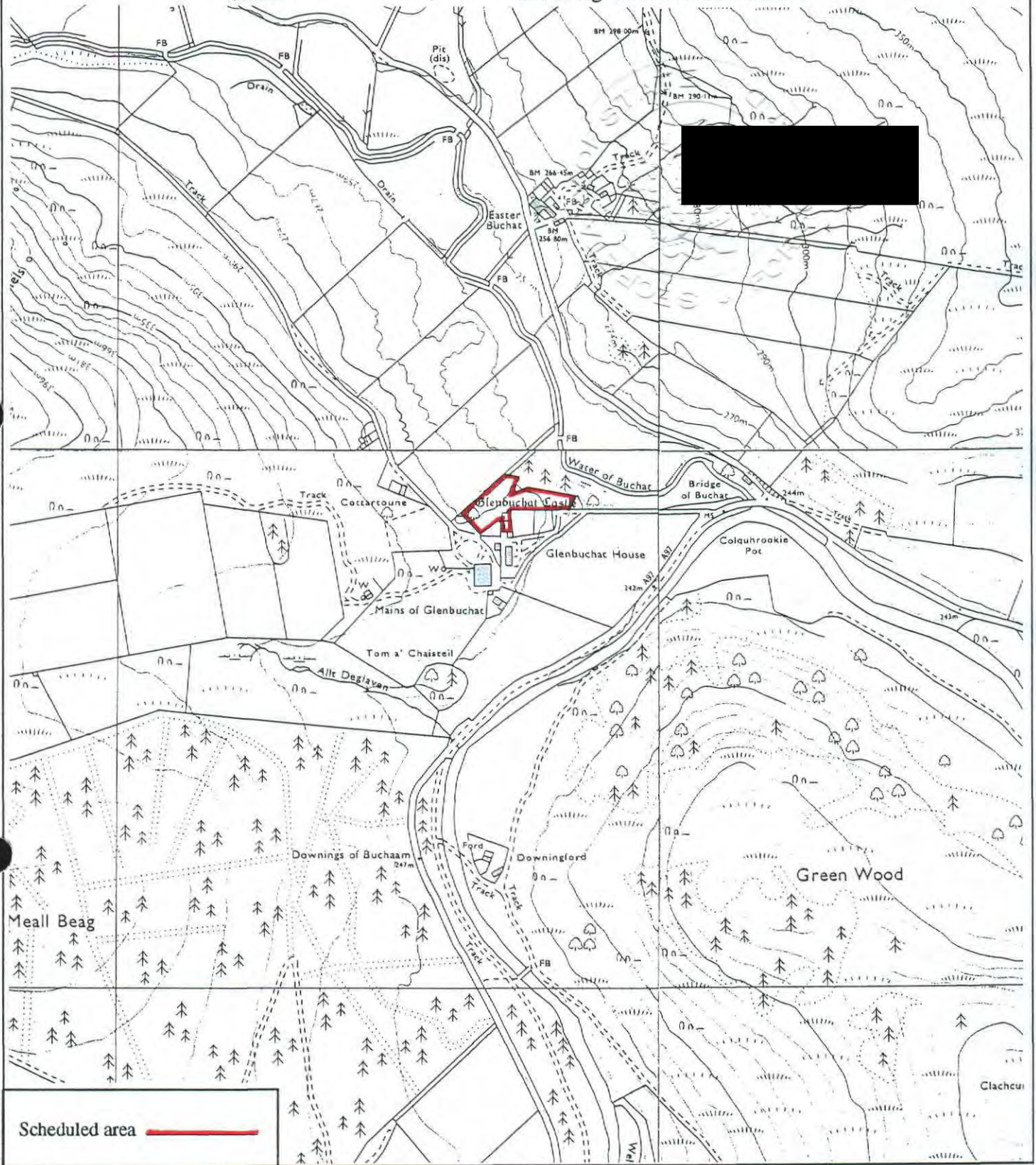

Scheduled area 

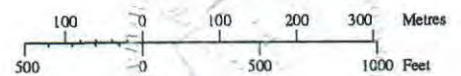
Glenbuchat Castle
