THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Huntly Castle comprises the remains of Huntly Castle and the tree-lined avenue that approaches it from the south. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, with maximum dimensions of 570m between its northernmost and southernmost points and 210m between its easternmost and westernmost points, to include the remains of the successive castles and the avenue that approaches them from Gordon Schools to the south, and an area of ground around the visible remains of the Castle and flanking the avenue, within which further evidence for the history of the site may survive. The top 30cm of all road surfaces is excluded, to allow for maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Huntly and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

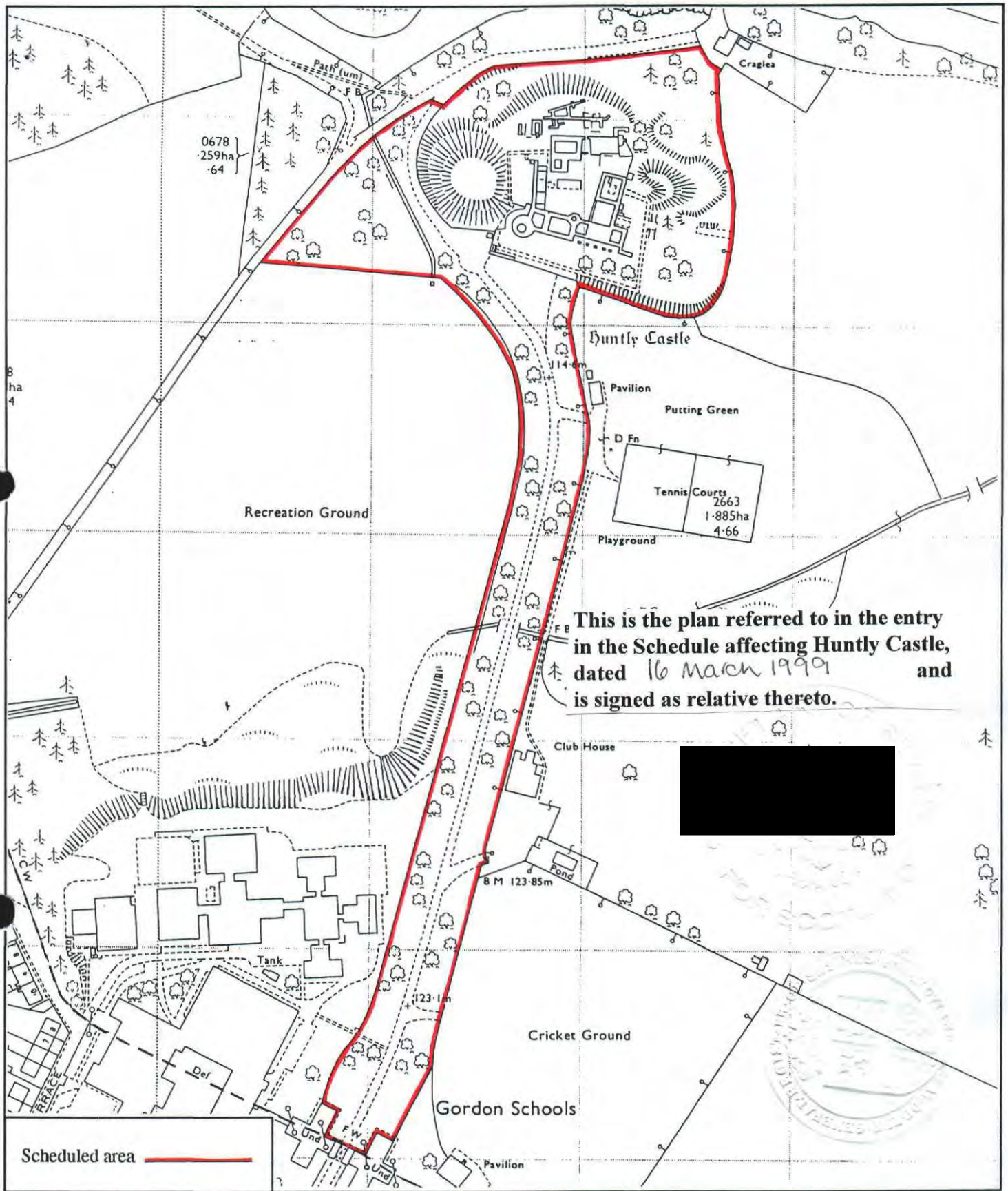

Scheduled area

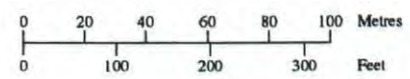
Huntly Castle
