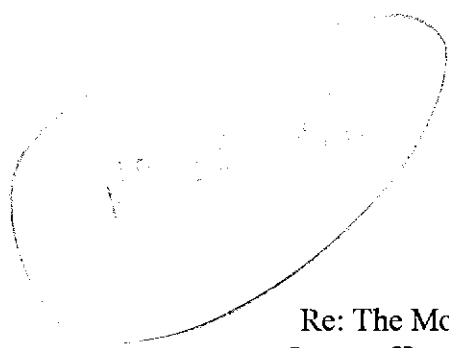

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Innerpeffray Collegiate Church comprises the rectangular collegiate church of Innerpeffray, together with the surrounding graveyard. The area to be scheduled consists of the entire graveyard, including the church, except for its NW corner, where the 18th century building which houses the library is excluded. This area measures a maximum of 48m by 38m, and is aligned just NW-SE of true N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Crieff and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

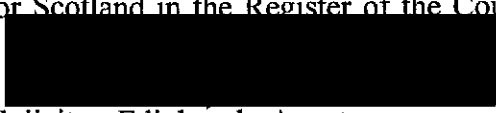
