ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Iona, McLean's Cross comprises a freestanding cross of 15th-century date. The area now to be scheduled includes the cross and its base with a small area around it. The area is a 2m square centred on, and aligned with, the cross. The surface of the modern road to the E and the field boundary to the W are excluded. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilfinichen and Kilvickeon and the County of Argyll as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the

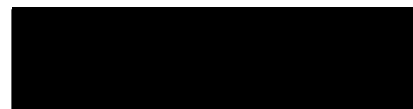
