

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Kinkell Church and burial ground comprises a church of late medieval date and its burial ground. It is in the care of the Secretary of State for Scotland. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described, including the graveyard wall and the area enclosed by it, within which related material may be expected to be found. It is trapezoidal with maximum dimensions of 50m NW-SE by 40m NE-SW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Keithhall and Kinkell and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, 

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

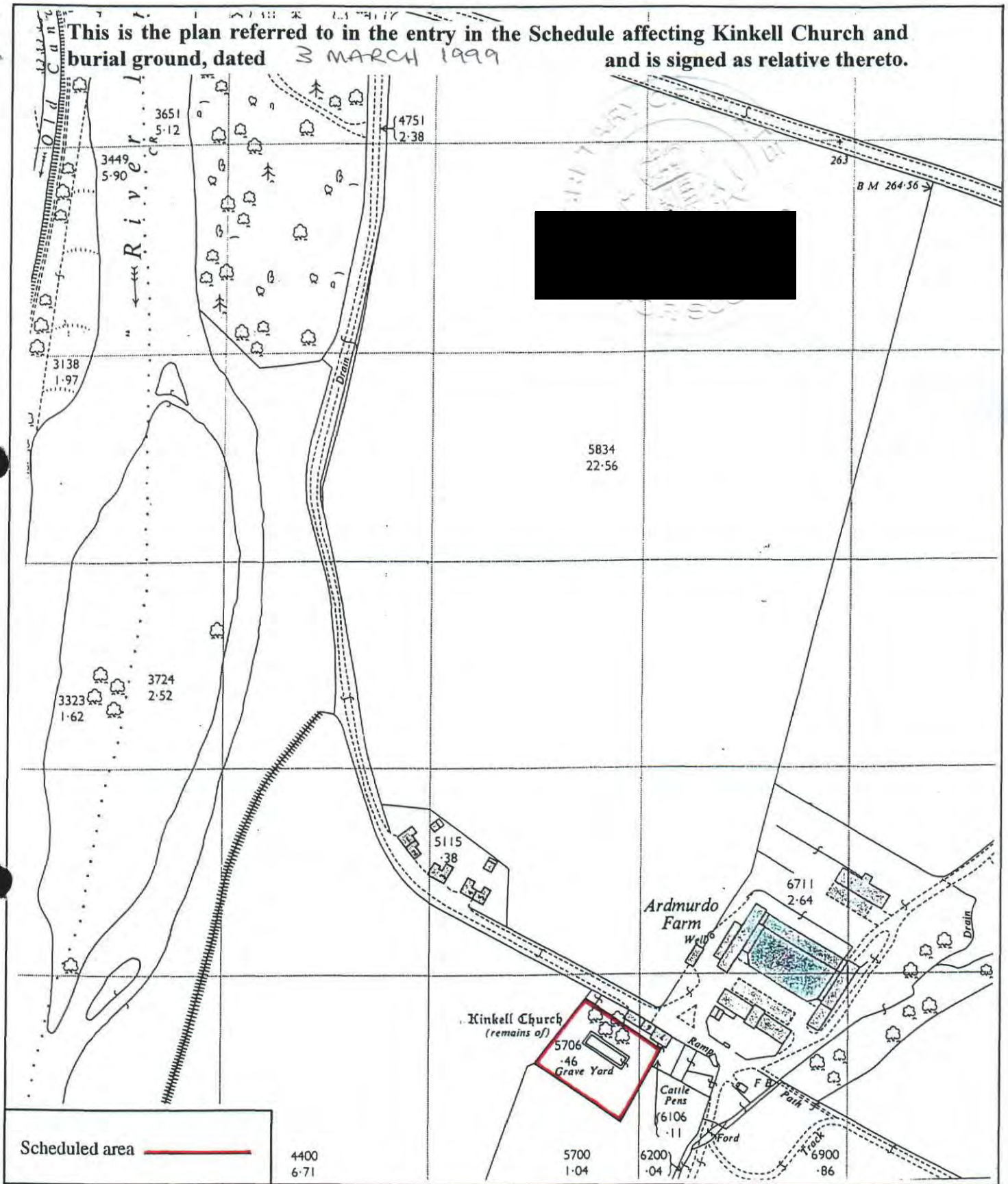

Scheduled area 4400 6-71

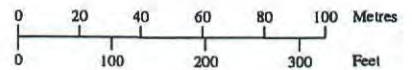
Kinkell Church and burial ground
