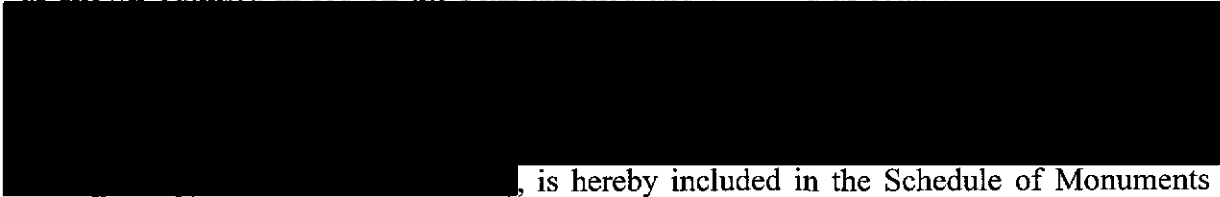

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Lochleven Castle comprises the remains of Lochleven Castle. The area to be scheduled encompasses the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to survive. It is irregular with measurements of 190m between its N and S-most points and 200m between its E and W-most points. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kinross and the County of Kinross as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

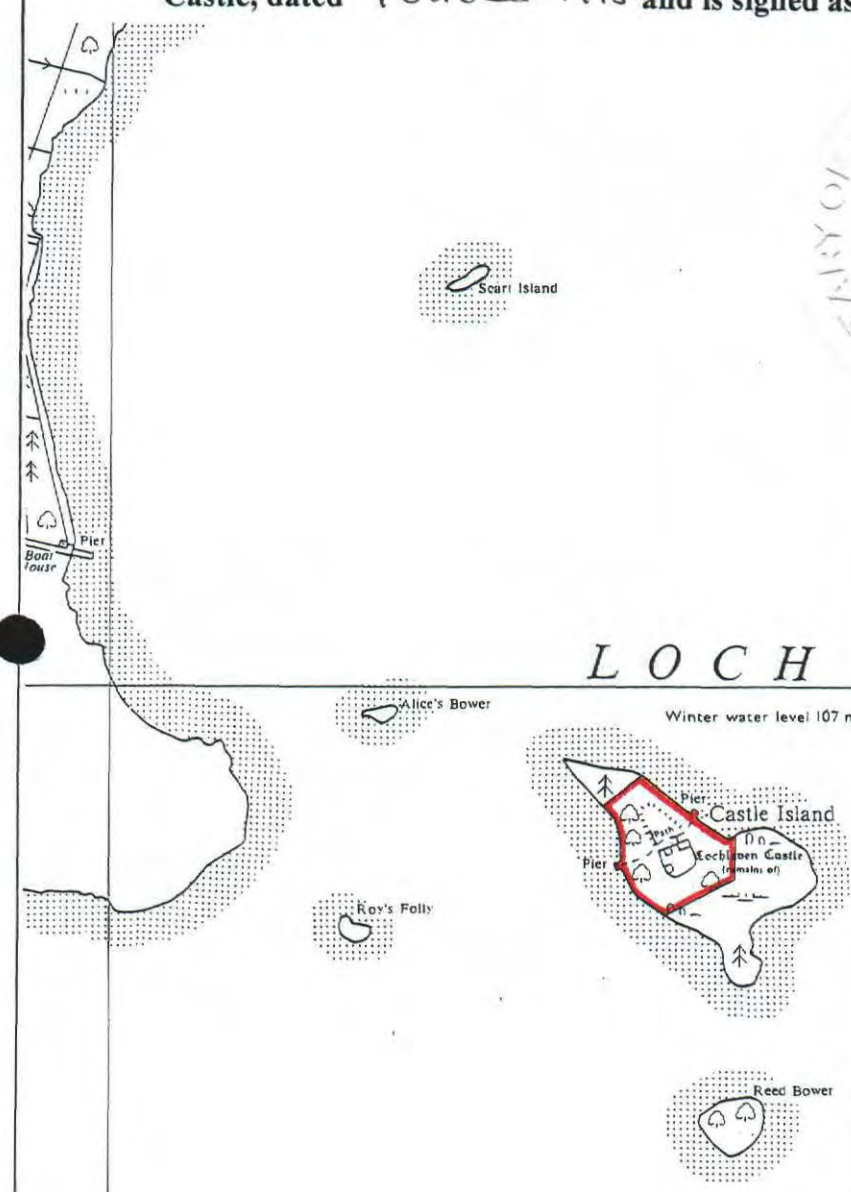

LOCH LEVEN


Winter water level 107 metres above Newlyn Datum 1973
