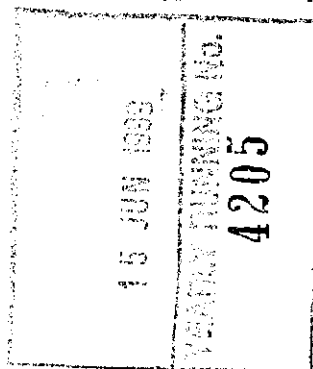

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Maiden Stone, cross slab comprises a Pictish cross-slab dating to the second half of the 1st millennium AD. The area to be scheduled comprises the stone and an area around it within which related material may be expected to be found. It is a truncated circle with a diameter of 20m, bounded on the NNE by the outer face of a retaining wall. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Chapel of Garioch and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

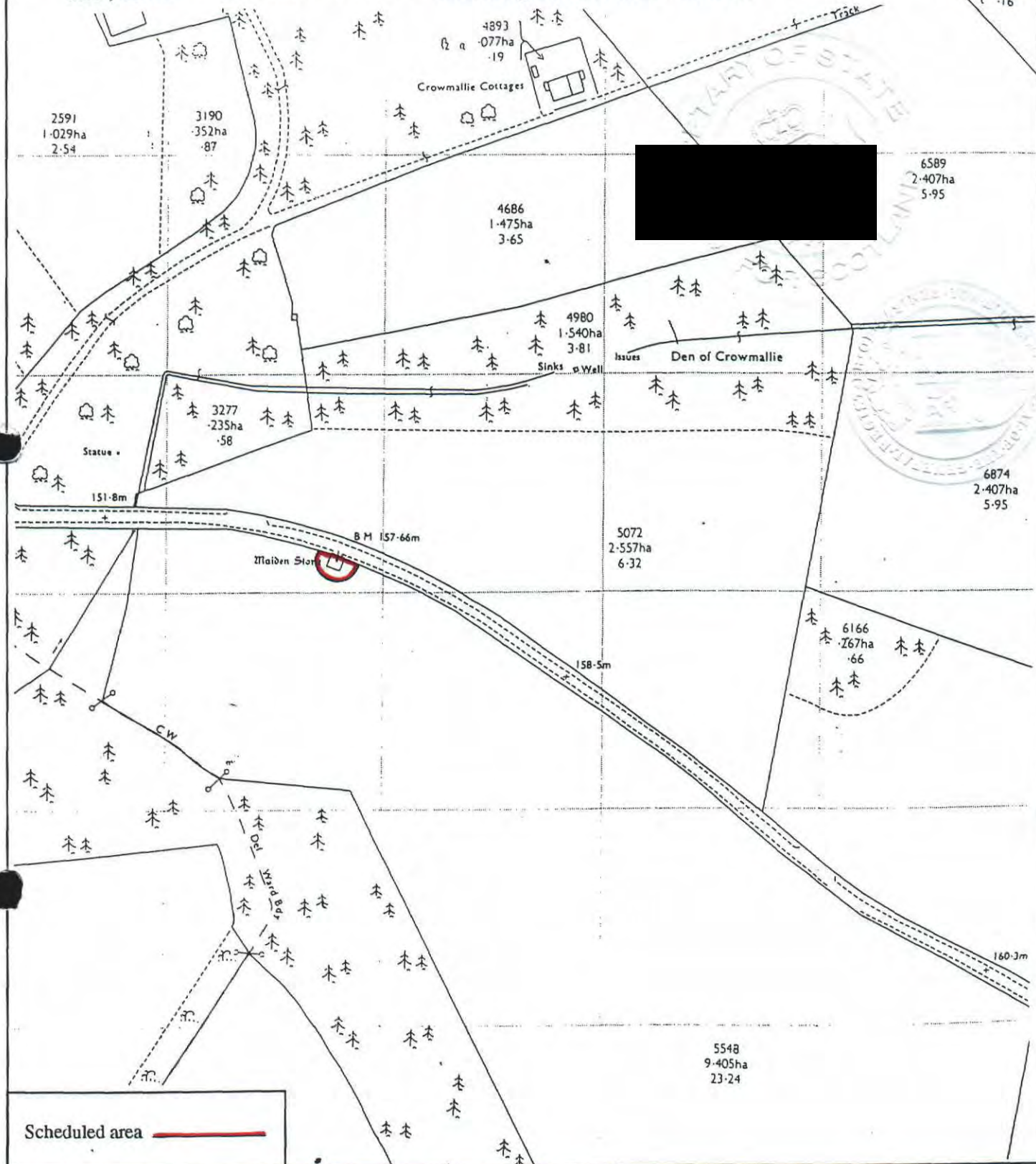

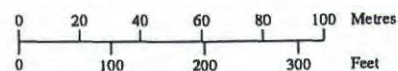
Maiden Stone, cross slab
