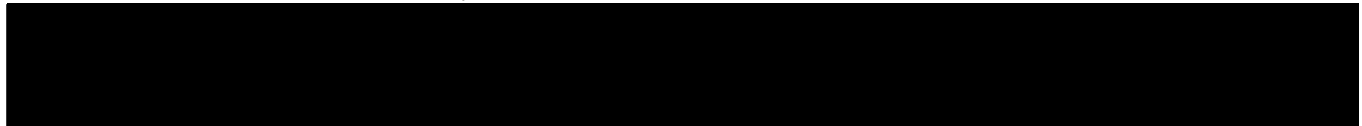

the owners of the Monument known as Morton Castle (in ruins) occupying a triangular promontory projecting northward into Morton Loch and measuring 140 yards from its northmost point to its eastmost point, 210 yards from its eastmost point to its westmost point and 180 yards from its westmost point to its northmost point, the westmost point of said promontory being situated 100 yards north-east at its nearest point of the road from Drumshinnoch to Thornhill Station by Morton Mains and 470 yards south-east by south of the south-eastmost corner of Morton Mains Farm Buildings being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of

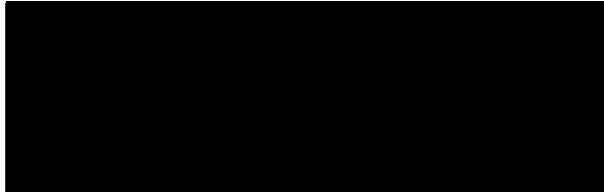
the property known as the Farm of Morton Mains

situated in the Parish of Morton and
County of Dumfries.



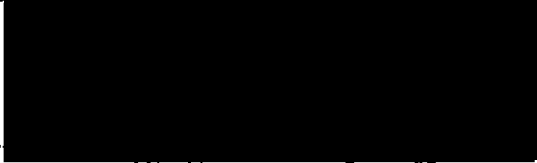

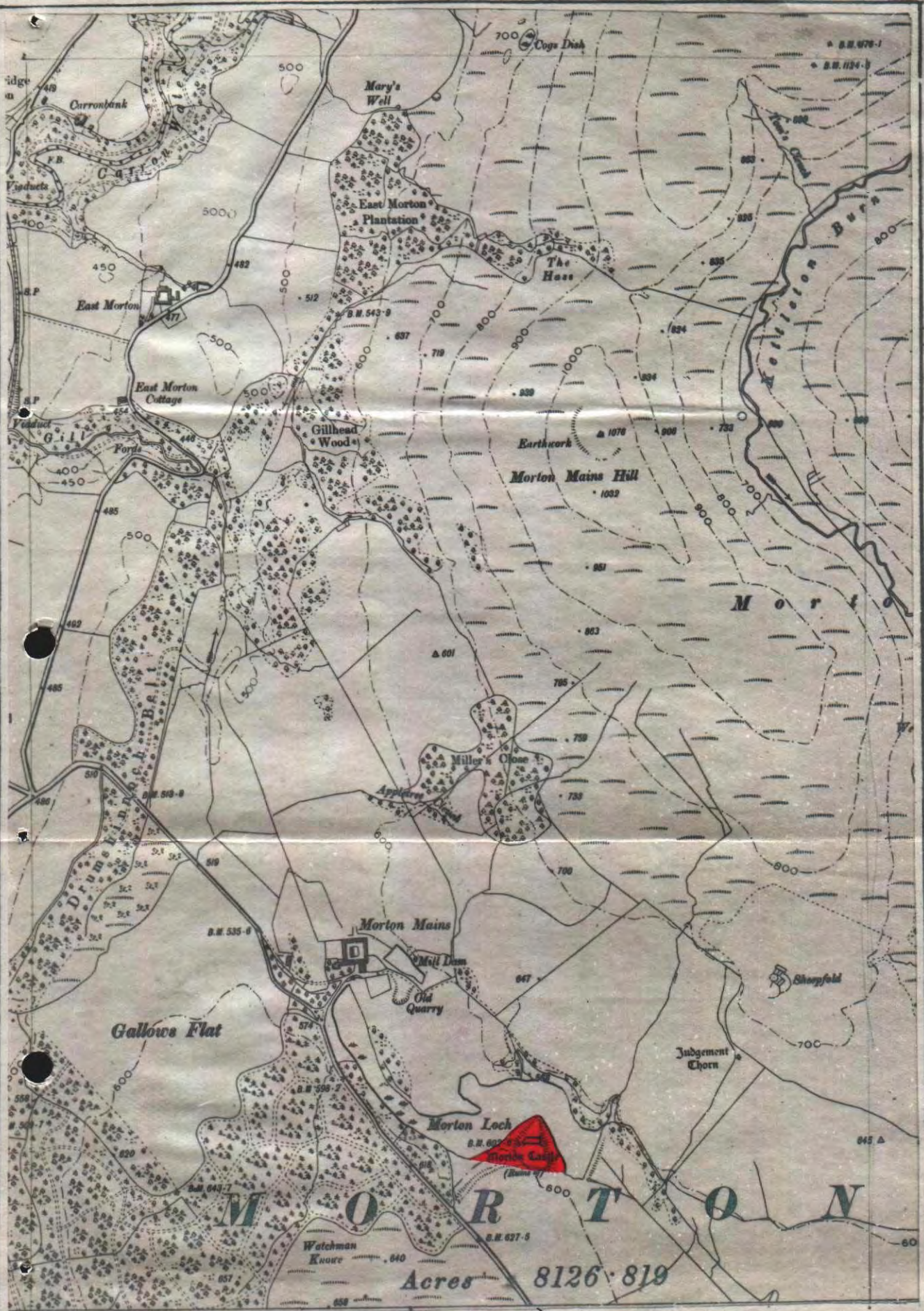
