The monument known as Moss Farm, cairn 870 m WNW of comprises a large kerbed cairn (sometimes also described as a stone circle) which is situated on the S side of the farm track to Moss Farm. The area to be scheduled measures 60m in diameter, to include the cairn and an area around in which associated remains may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmory and the County of Bute as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

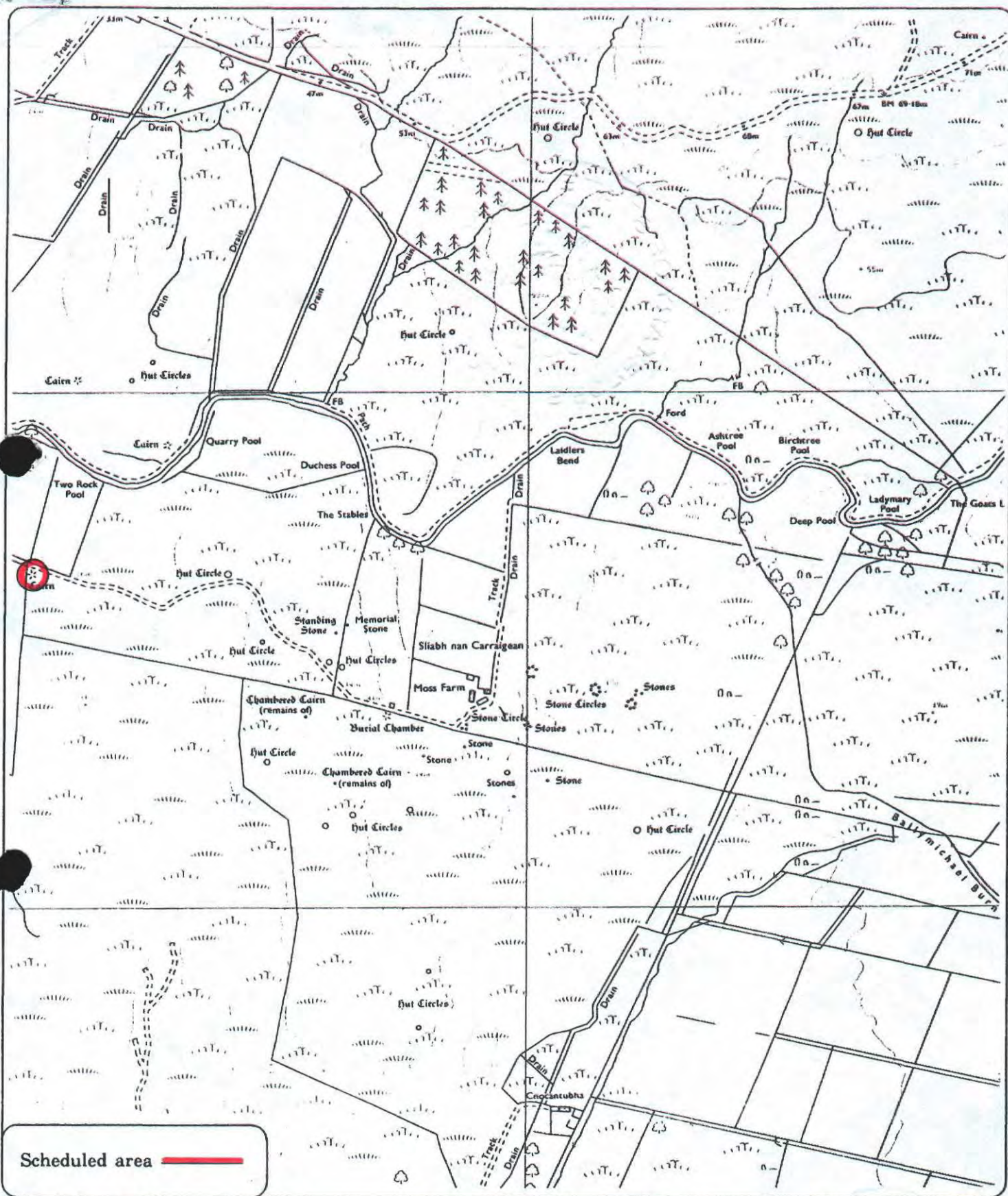

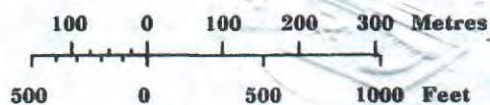
