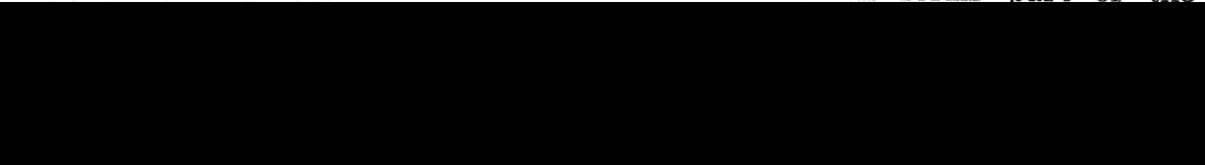

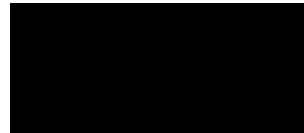

The monument known as Knowe of Onston, or Unstan, chambered cairn comprises a Neolithic chambered cairn on low-lying ground beside the Loch of Stenness. The area to be scheduled is that contained within the boundary fence, and measures some 19m E-W by 17m N-S. The fence and concrete roof are included. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Stenness and the County of Orkney as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the

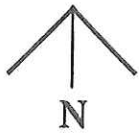

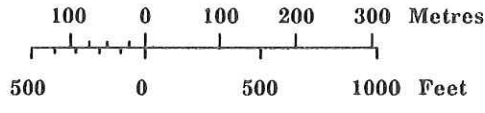
