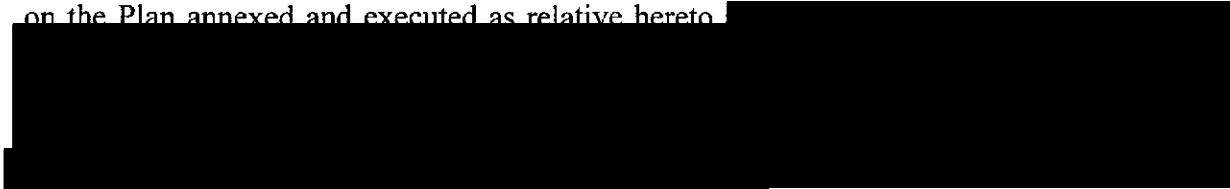


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979

The monument known as Rispain Camp, comprises the remains of Rispain Camp, a small late Iron Age defended farm or fort, surviving as well preserved earthworks. It occupies a commanding position overlooking the rolling fields of the South Machars of Galloway, 1.5km W of Whithorn. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described. It is sub-rectangular with maximum dimensions of 132m E-W by 93m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Whithorn and the County of Wigton as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

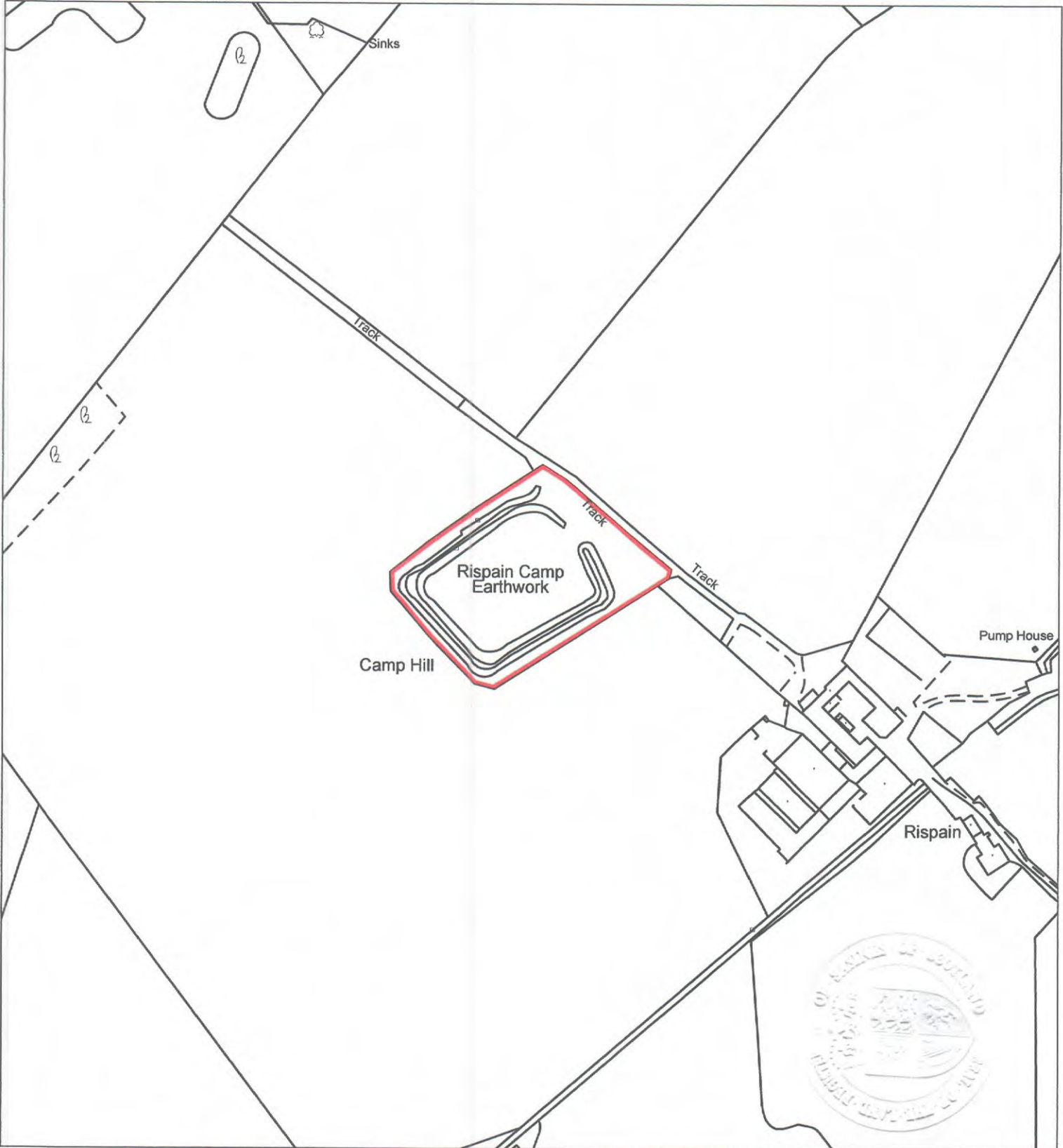
