# IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

the owners of the Monument known as the remains of Saint Serf's Priory contained within a rectangular area of ground on Saint Serf's Island in Loch Leven measuring 180 feet along each of its north and south sides, and 120 feet along each of its east and west sides, the south-east point of said area being situated 110 yards west-south-west at its nearest point of the shore of the bay on the east side of said Island, 130 yards north-west by north of the south-east shore of said Island at its nearest point and 160 yards north of the southmost point of said island

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as **Saint Serf's Island**

situated in the Parish of **Portmoak** and  
County of **Kinross**.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
