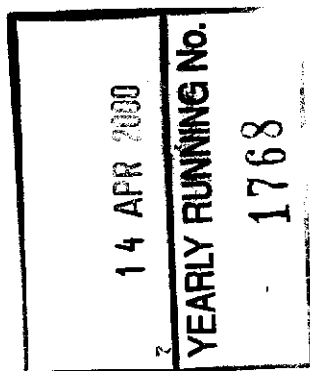

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Scotstarvit Tower comprises a tower house which occupies a ridge overlooking the valleys of the River Eden and Craigrothie Burn. The area to be scheduled is irregular in plan with maximum dimensions of 49m NNW-SSE by 47m transversely, to include the tower house and area around it within which associated remains are likely to survive. The area is bounded on the N, S and W by existing boundary walls. The E boundary runs from its N-most point SSE for 31m, then turns WSW for 16m and finally runs SSE for 19m to meet the existing boundary wall. This marks the E-most corner of the S boundary of the scheduled area. All existing boundary walls and the top 30cm of the pathways which circumscribe the tower are excluded from this scheduling to allow for maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Ceres and the County of Fife as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

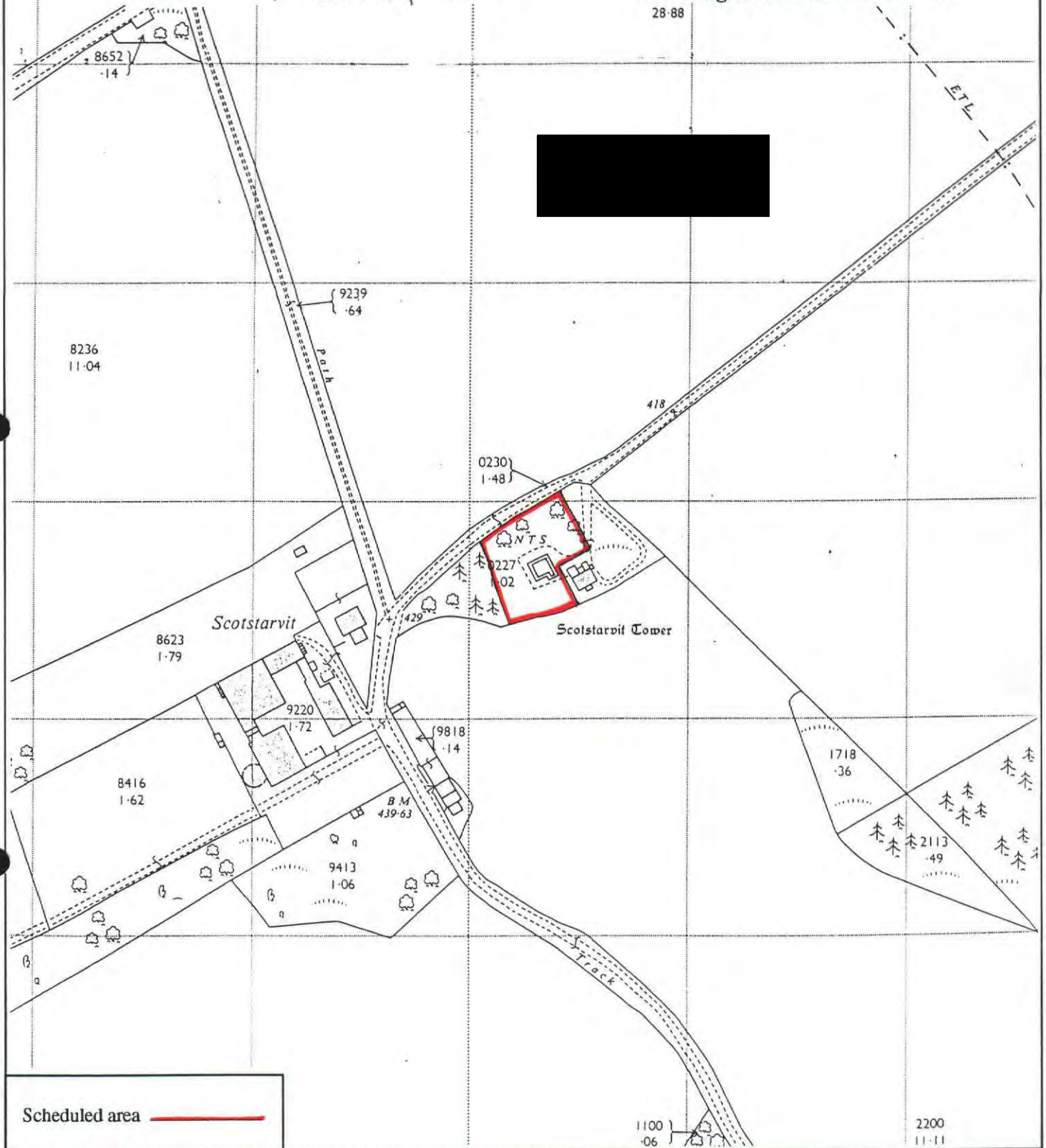

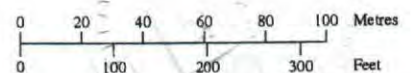
Scotstarvit Tower
