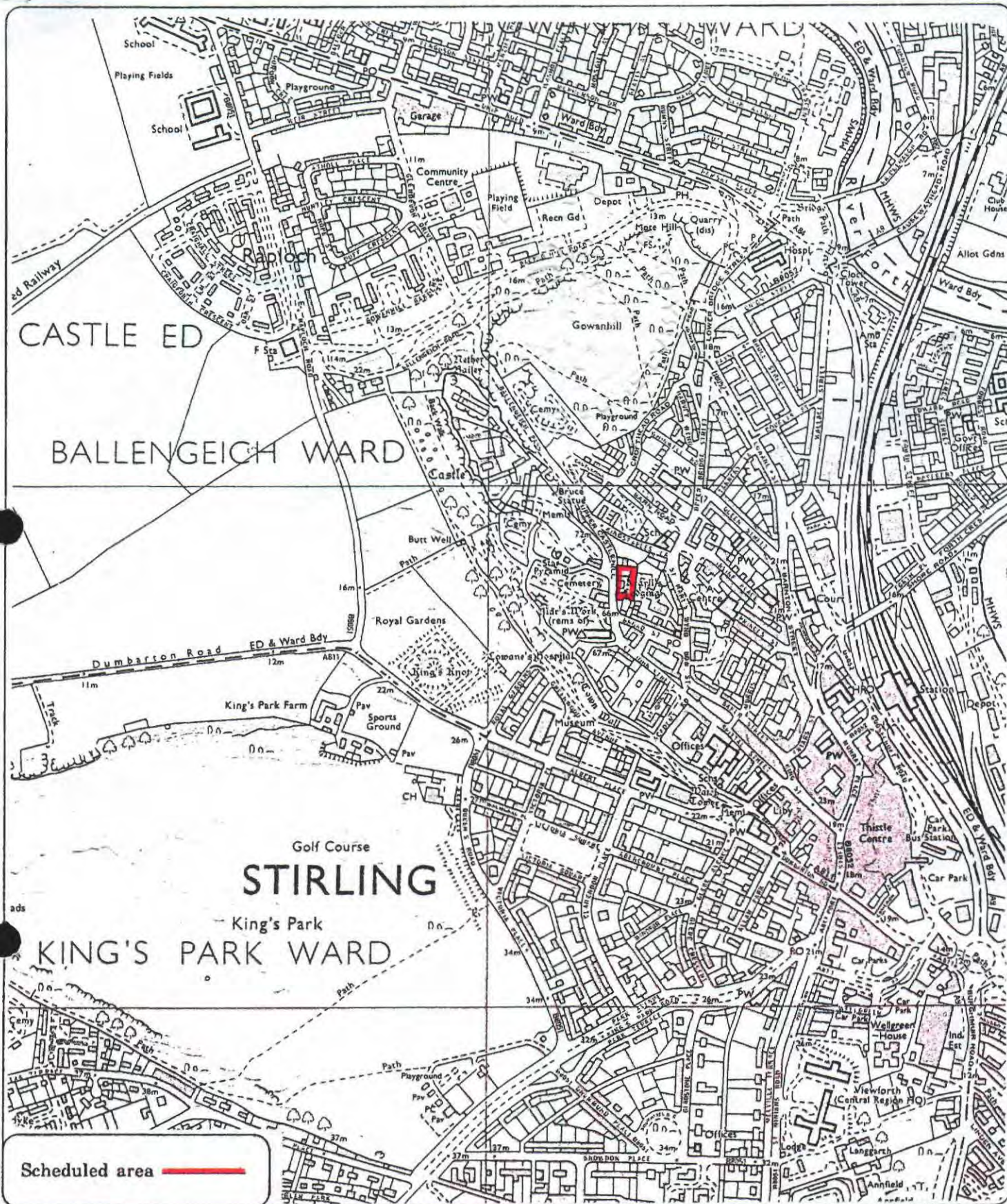

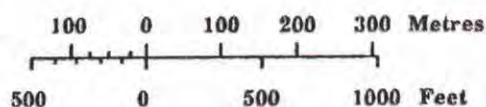
Stirling, Argyll Lodging, house
