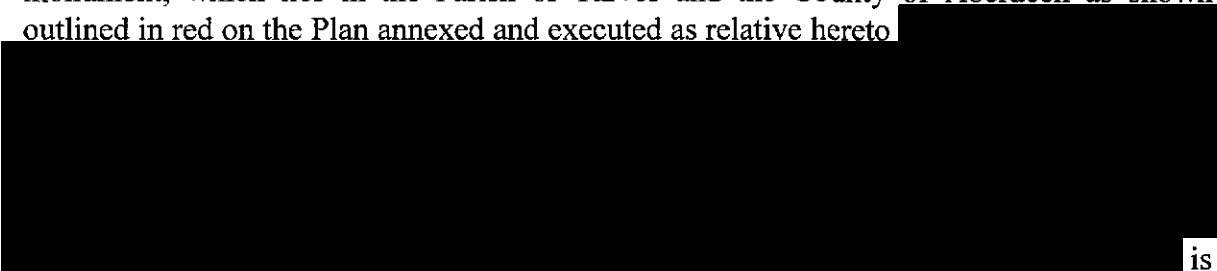

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Tarves, Tolquhon Tomb, S of Parish Church comprises the altar tomb erected in 1589 in memory of William Forbes, 7th Laird of Tolquhon, and his wife Elizabeth Gordon, in the south aisle of the former parish Church of Tarves. The area to be scheduled represents an area measuring from 9.06m to 8.75m E-W by 8.35m N-S, including the tomb, the wall into which it is built, the modern shelter containing it and a strip 2m wide surrounding it, lying 9.5m south of the S wall of the parish church. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Tarves and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

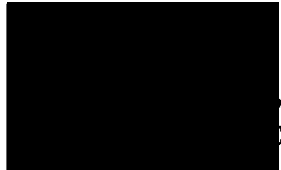

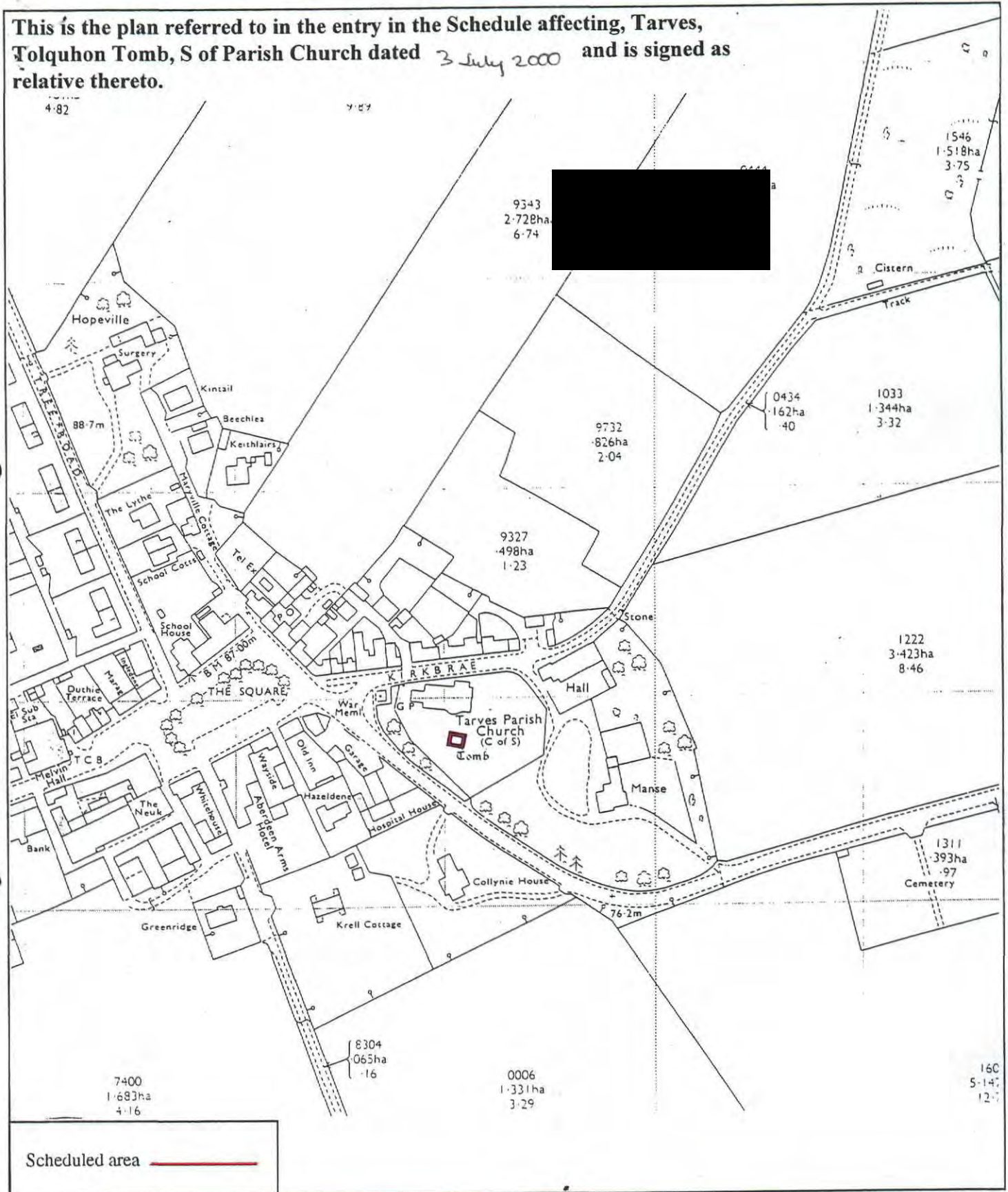
