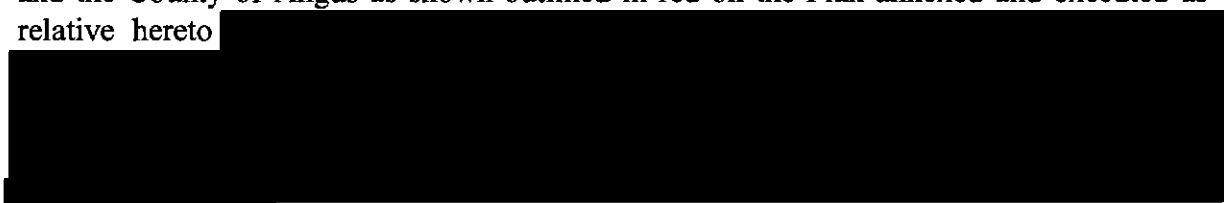

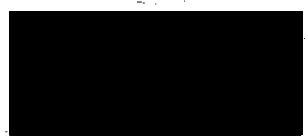

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Tealing Doocot comprises a rubble-built, rectangular-shaped late 16th-century doocot with crow-stepped gables and moulded rat course. The area to be scheduled is a rectangle including the doocot and an area of ground extending 2m out from the outer face of its walls on all sides. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Tealing and the County of Angus as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

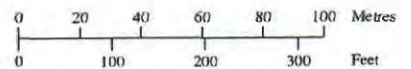
