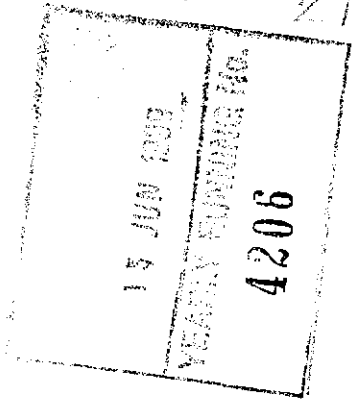

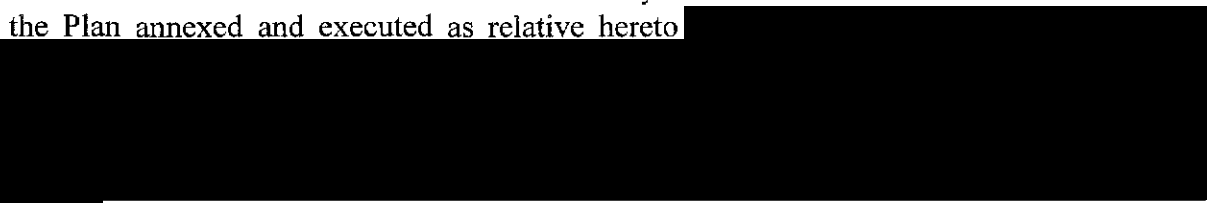

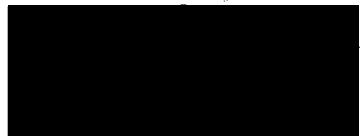
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Tolquhon Castle comprises a castle and associated buildings of 15th and 16th century date. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It measures a maximum of 252m, approximately NW-SE by 154m NE-SW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Tarves and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

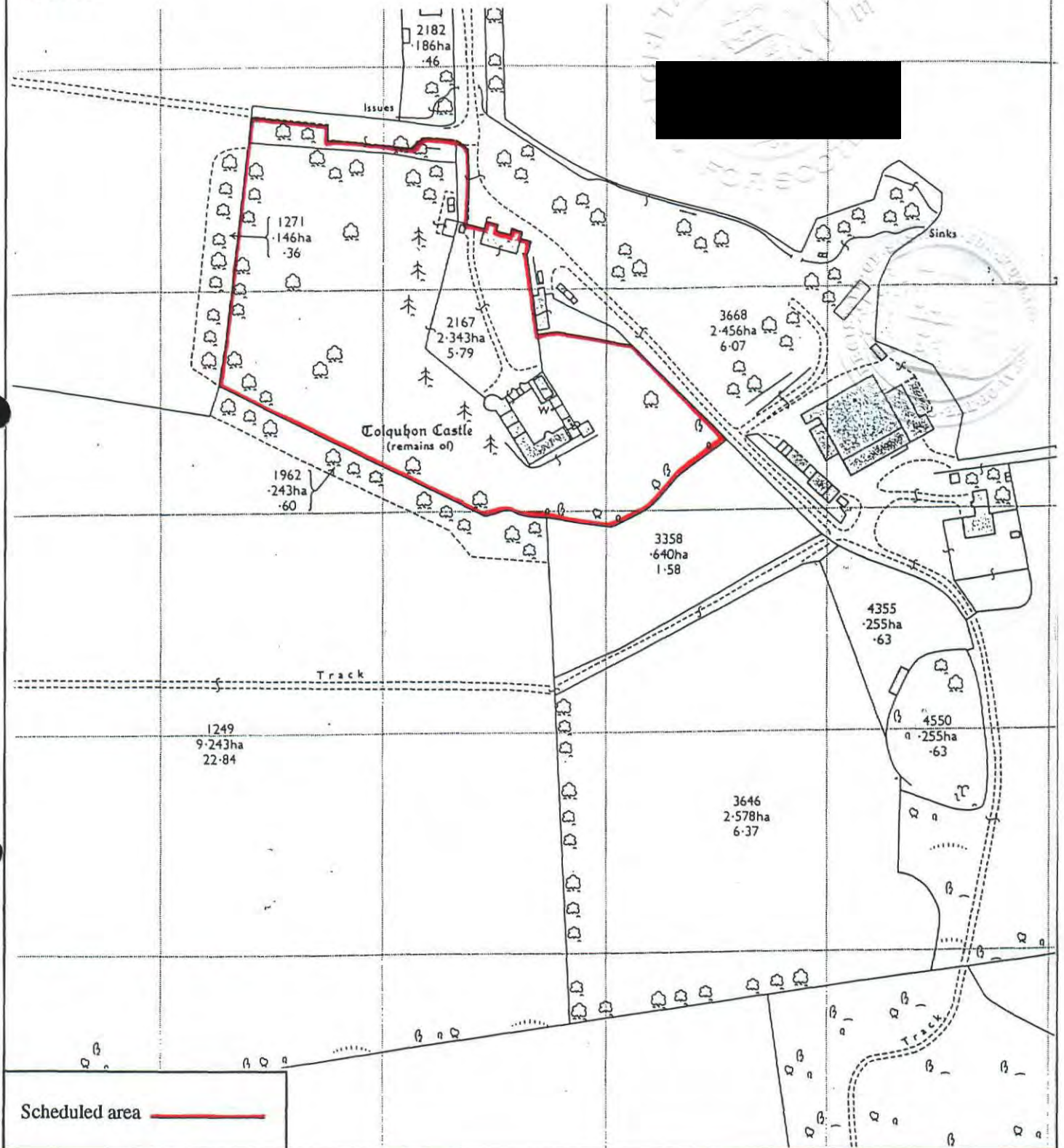

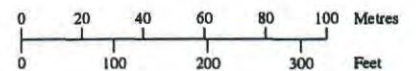
